

Louisiana HIV, AIDS, Early Syphilis, & Congenital Syphilis Surveillance

Quarterly Report

December 31, 2025



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Surveillance Summary – Fourth Quarter 2025

State and National Context

In 2023, Louisiana ranked fourth in the nation for HIV diagnosis rates, with 18.8 new diagnoses per 100,000 population. For primary and secondary (P&S) syphilis, the state ranked eighth nationally with a rate of 26.1 per 100,000 population. HIV burden remains especially high in Louisiana's largest metro areas: the New Orleans metropolitan statistical area (MSA) ranked 6th for HIV diagnosis rates the Baton Rouge MSA ranked 10th, with 23.1 and 21.3 diagnoses per 100,000 population, respectively. Louisiana also ranked seventh in the nation for congenital syphilis in 2023, with a rate of 193 cases per 100,000 live births and 109 cases reported.

HIV

As of December 31, 2025, 24,027 people were living with HIV (PLWH) in Louisiana among whom 46% (n=11,150) had received an AIDS diagnosis. In 2024, 863 people were newly diagnosed with HIV. Of those, 27% (n=229) were diagnosed in Region 1 (New Orleans), and 17% (n=151) in Region 2 (Baton Rouge). Gay, bisexual, and other men who have sex with men (GBM) continue to represent the leading reported risk factor for HIV acquisition in Louisiana. Among people newly diagnosed with HIV in 2024 who reported a risk factor, 59% identified as GBM, and an additional 2% identified as both GBM and a person who injects drugs. As of December 2025, 48% of all people living with HIV in Louisiana with a known risk factor were GBM.

Early Syphilis

From January 1 through December 31, 2025, 1,501 people were newly diagnosed with early syphilis in Louisiana. This included 763 diagnoses of primary or secondary syphilis and 738 diagnoses of early non-primary non-secondary (early non-P&S) syphilis. Regionally, 16% (n=247) of these diagnoses were diagnosed in Region 1 (New Orleans), and 19% (n=282) were diagnosed in Region 2 (Baton Rouge). Among people diagnosed with early syphilis in Louisiana from January 1 to December 31, 2025 who reported risk, 67% reported heterosexual activity, 37% reported any form of illegal drug use, and 34% identified as gay, bisexual, or other men who have sex with men (GBM). Individuals could report more than one risk factor.

Congenital Syphilis

From January 1 through December 31st 2025, 77 cases were reported in Louisiana. These cases were linked to 75 mothers. Among these mothers, 21% (n=16) resided in Region 4 (Lafayette), 60% (n=45) were Black, and 33% (n=25) were between 30 to 34 years of age at delivery. These data are preliminary and are subject to change.

Demographic Highlights and Disparities

Across HIV, AIDS, and early syphilis, the majority of new diagnoses continue to occur among men. In 2024, 73% of people newly diagnosed with HIV and AIDS were male, and in the fourth quarter of 2025, men accounted for 64% of early syphilis diagnoses. Black Louisianans continue to experience disproportionate impacts from HIV and STIs. Although they represent only 32% of the state's population, Black individuals accounted for 66% of new HIV diagnoses and 71% of AIDS diagnoses in 2024. In the fourth quarter of 2025, 64% of early syphilis diagnoses with a reported race/ethnicity were among Black individuals. Adolescents and young adults remain highly affected. In 2024, 24% of new HIV diagnoses occurred in individuals aged 13 to 24, and 35% were among those aged 25 to 34. A similar pattern was observed for early syphilis in the fourth quarter of 2025, with 15% of diagnoses in the 13–24 age group and 36% among those aged 25–34.

* A syphilis diagnosis with less than one year duration is considered to be "early syphilis." This designation covers the primary, secondary, and early non-P&S stages of syphilis.

Changes to Gender Variable

The gender variable now encompasses five genders: man, woman, transgender man, transgender woman, and additional gender identity. The gender category “additional gender identity” was added to include those who identified as gender queer, gender non-conforming, or non-binary. Gender defaults to birth sex unless a gender identity different from birth sex has been collected from medical chart review, case management notes, or during a partner services interview. People of transgender and additional gender identities are likely undercounted.

Changes to Syphilis Case Definition

The Quarterly Report includes revisions to the surveillance case definition for syphilis as approved by the Council of State and Territorial Epidemiologists (CSTE) effective January 1, 2018. Of note, the nomenclature for “Early latent syphilis” has been changed to “Early non-primary non-secondary syphilis.” Throughout the Quarterly Report it has been abbreviated to “Early non-P&S syphilis.” Please refer to the following documentation for additional information on all other syphilis case definition revisions: <https://www.cdc.gov/sti-statistics/media/pdfs/2024/10/CaseDefinitions2023.pdf>.

Congenital Syphilis Case Definition

A case of congenital syphilis (CS) occurs when a pregnant woman diagnosed with inadequately treated syphilis passes the infection on to her infant in utero or during delivery. This may result in stillbirth, death of the newborn, or significant future health and developmental problems. A wide spectrum of severity exists, from inapparent infection to severe cases that are clinically apparent at birth. An infant or child (aged less than 2 years) may have signs such as hepatosplenomegaly, rash, condyloma lata, snuffles, jaundice (nonviral hepatitis), pseudoparalysis, anemia, or edema (nephrotic syndrome and/or malnutrition). An older child may have stigmata (e.g., interstitial keratitis, nerve deafness, anterior bowing of shins, frontal bossing, mulberry molars, Hutchinson teeth, saddle nose, rhagades, or Clutton joints).

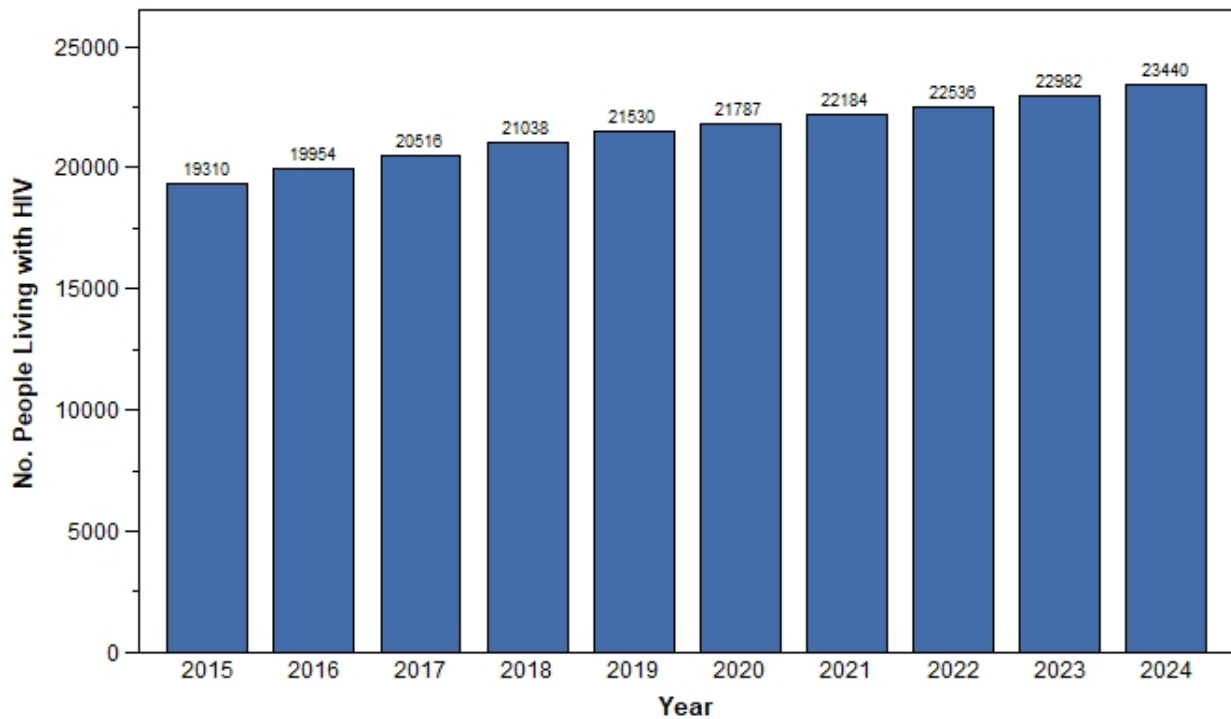

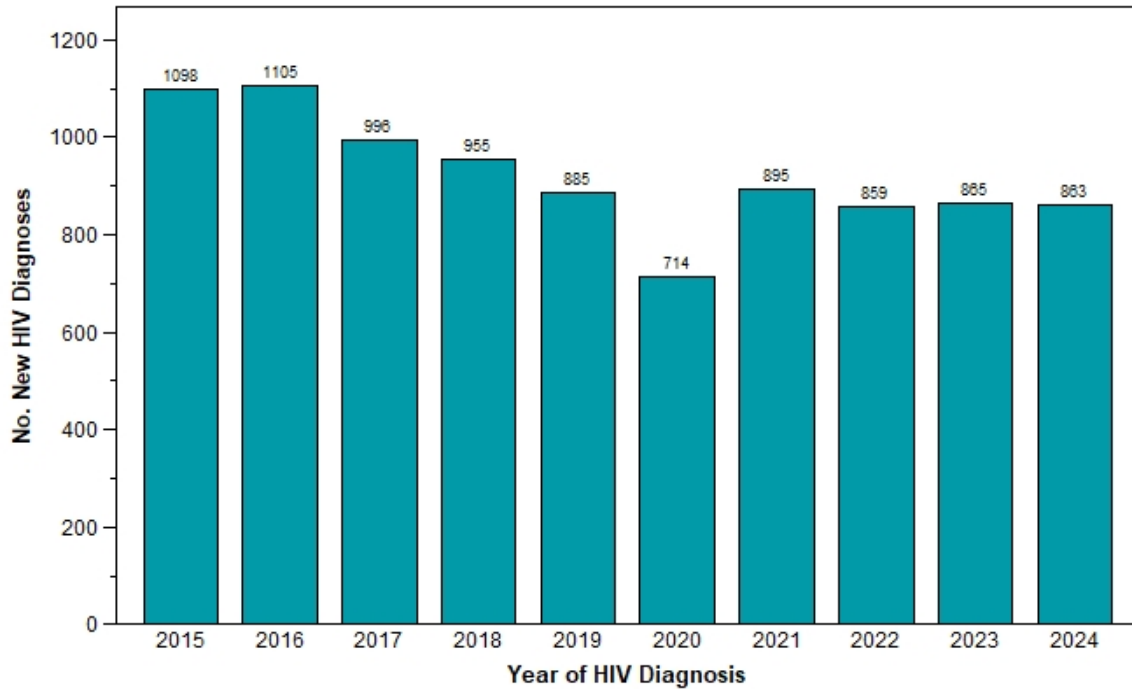

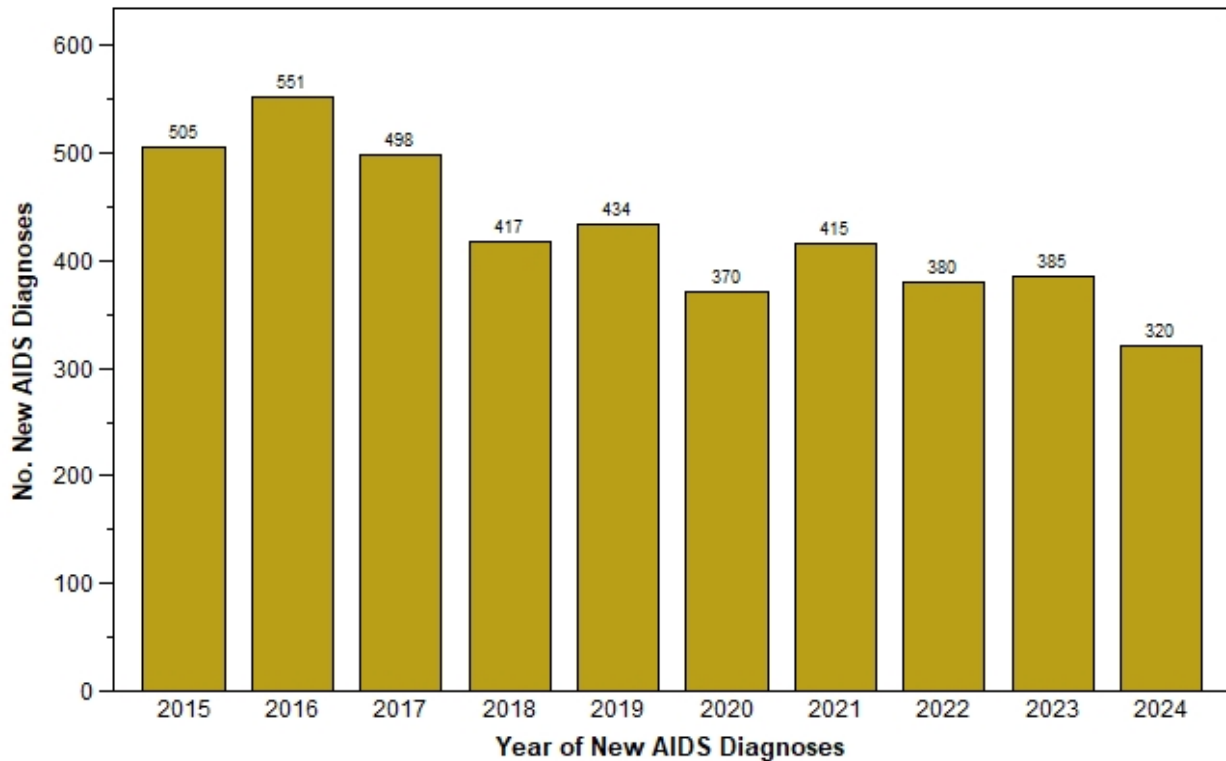

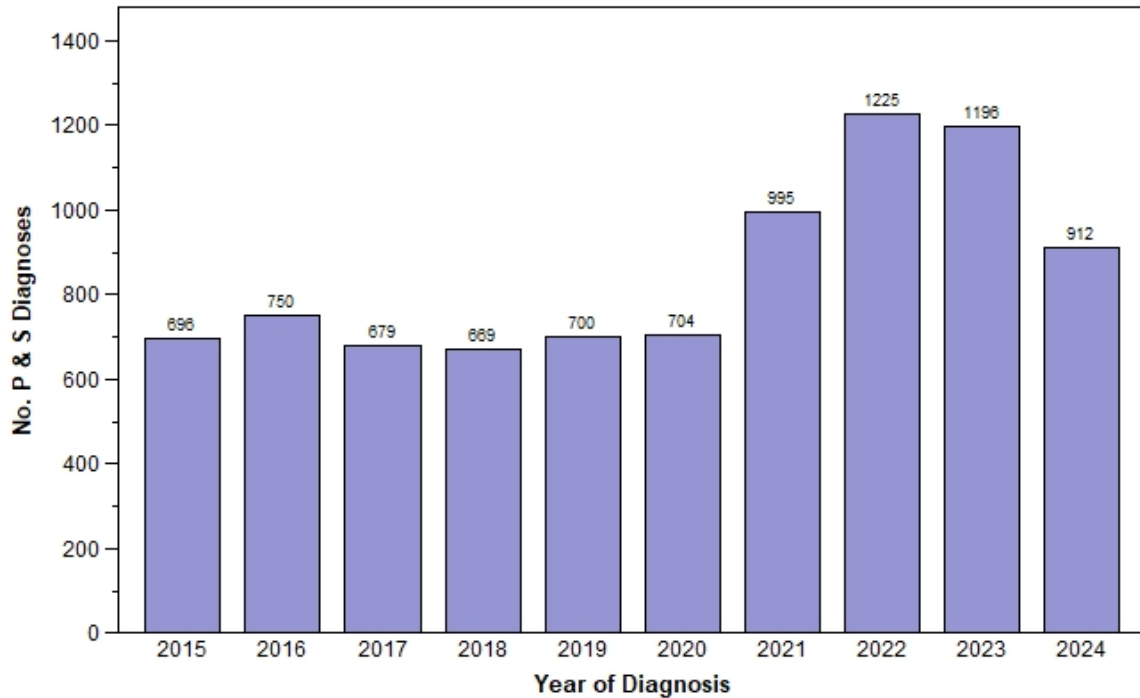

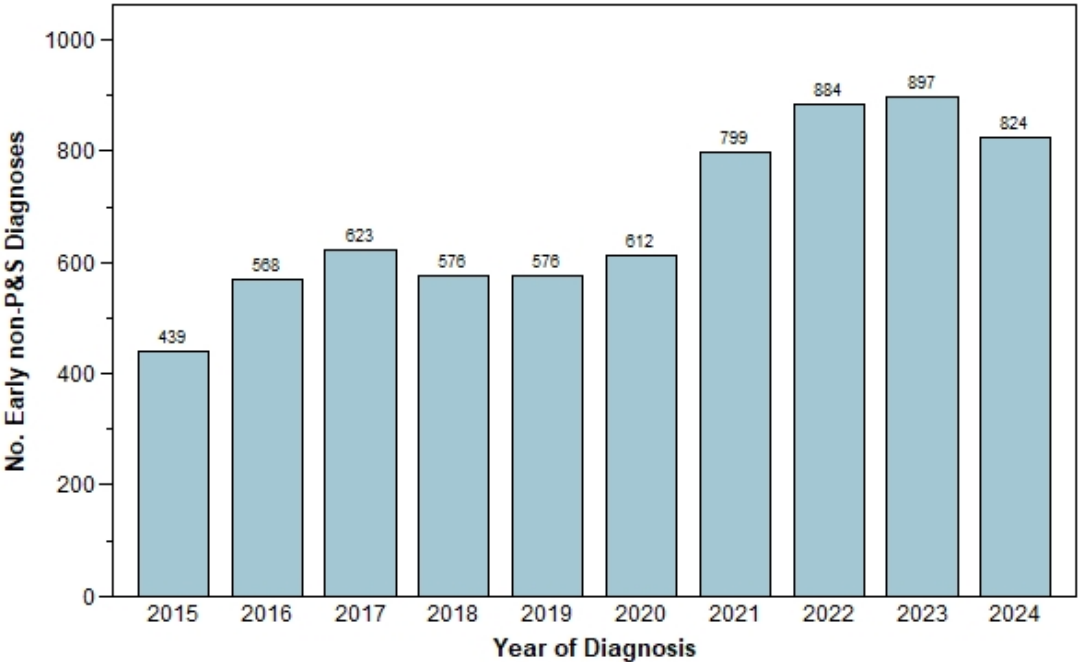

Louisiana, 2015-2024**

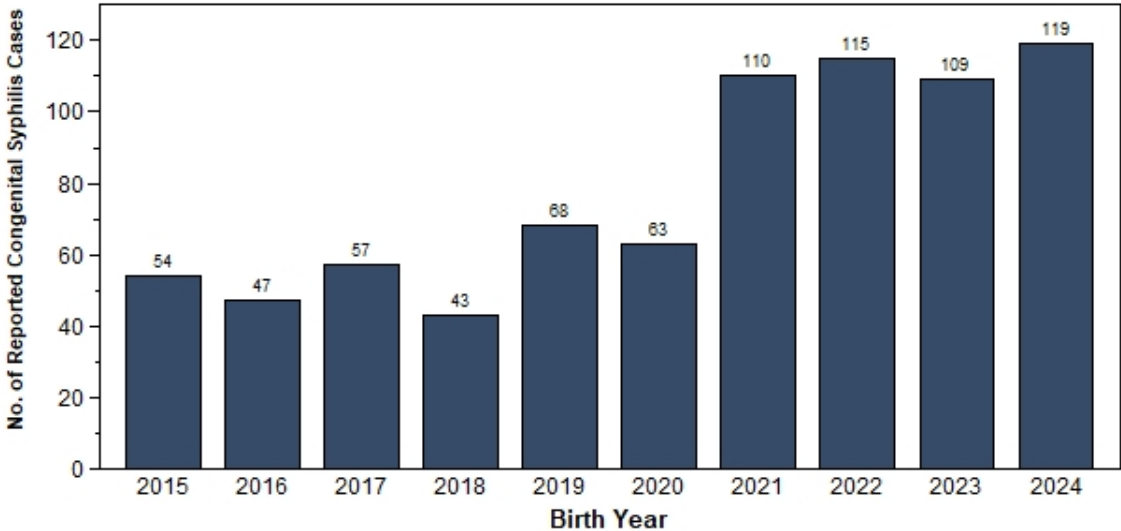
