
Presentation Update

- LDH emailed response to Randal Johnson 10/5/2022
- The set of data in Slide 24 cannot be compared to Enrollment Trends report.
 - The Trends report is the source of the total unduplicated population of 1.9M. This report is populated directly after the month ends and is a point in time report.
 - Previous months being reported do not get an updated enrollment. This is different from the enrollment counts provided on the slide 24, which is an aggregate of SFY'21.
- These reports have different purposes/data sources and aren't meant to be compared.





- The 316,116 FFS enrollees in SFY'21 consist of anyone enrolled in a Medicaid program within the 12 months that did not have full coverage, or 'P', linkage to an MCO.
- Approximately 84%, of the 316K SFY'21 enrollees, were not eligible for full MCO coverage due to having Medicare Part B coverage. Members with Medicare Part B coverage are enrolled in a full Medicaid coverage program, the State is responsible for the co-pay of servicing using FFS.



- Slide 25 is accurate as reported by Magellan SIN report.
- The 1.6M represented in the slide for unduplicated pharmacy recipients is not the total enrolled population figure. It is the number of recipients who had at least one (1) claim that was invoiced.
- The 19,179,502 represents the total number of prescriptions that can be rebated.
