

# Louisiana Coordinated System of Care (CSoC) Director's Report to the Governance Board

### Highlights and News

- CSoC referrals and enrollment were up this quarter.
- The Louisiana Model for Coaching and Training workgroup continued to meet weekly during the quarter. The wraparound agencies are currently piloting the new training materials. Full implementation will begin on April 1, 2025.
  - Previously, the state has operated under two separate training and coaching models. All wraparound agencies will operate under the new model going forward.
  - This was a collaborative effort that included representatives from each wraparound agency, Magellan, and the OBH CSoC team.
  - OBH would like to thank the wraparound agencies and Magellan for the hard work they put into developing and refining training materials for the new model.








# Child and Adolescent Needs and Strengths (CANS) Outcomes: Clinical Functioning






# CANS Outcomes: Reduction in Prevalence of Actionable Needs (2023)


#### CANS Outcomes: Improvements in Strength Items (2023)


# CANS Outcomes: Top 10 Needs with Greatest Prevalence Reduction (2023)


# Parent Support and Training (PST) Utilization


### Youth Support and Training (YST) Utilization




# Living Situation at Discharge
