Service Changes:

- Non-Emergency Medical Transportation (NEMT) will be provided by the Bayou Health plan provider.
- Prescription Drugs
 - If enrolled in a Bayou Health plan for physical health benefits, RX drugs will be covered by the Bayou Health plan.
 - If enrolled in a Bayou Health plan for Specialized Behavioral Health benefits only, RX drugs will be covered by legacy (fee-for-service) Medicaid.
- Specialized Behavioral Health services (mental health and substance abuse services) will be handled by the Bayou Health plan provider instead of Magellan, except for CSoC.
