Emergency Contraception Preferred Products As a Medicaid MCO Outpatient Pharmacy Benefit

- **Prescription Is Required, Even If Over-the-Counter (OTC)**
- **Preferred Products do not require Prior Authorization (PA)**
- Prior authorization for products that are not preferred should be processed in 24 hours or less
