Humana Pharmacy Claims Processing

Pharmacies may now process Humana pharmacy claims at Point of Sale (POS) with the **Humana "H" ID number** printed on the Humana card. Pharmacy claims will continue to process when billed with the recipient's legacy Medicaid ID or Card Control Number (CCN).

The BIN and PCN remain the same as Fee-for-Service (FFS) billing (BIN: 610514 and PCN:LOUIPROD), but with the addition of **HUMANA** as a group ID. If a Humana pharmacy claim is billed without **HUMANA** in NCPDP field 301-C1 (Group ID), the claim will deny with EOB 367 (group number is missing or invalid for Humana), which is mapped to NCPDP Reject Code 06.

FFS Lifts X-DEA Requirement for Buprenorphine Products

Due to the 2023 Consolidated Appropriations Act, the Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA) is no longer requiring prescribers to have an X-DEA number to prescribe buprenorphine products. Fee-for-Service (FFS) has lifted this requirement on Point of Sale pharmacy claims for buprenorphine products.
