The Restore Louisiana Homeowner Assistance Program is dedicated to helping homeowners affected by the March and/or August 2016 floods repair and restore their damaged homes, or get reimbursed for work already completed.

STEP 1: COMPLETE THE SURVEY

by visiting **Restore.LA.gov** or by calling **866-735-2001**.

The first step in the Restore Louisiana Homeowner Assistance Program is to complete a brief survey. The survey should take about 15 minutes to complete, and no documentation is required.

Your survey responses will help us understand where you are in your recovery and what phase of the program you may qualify for.

STEP 2: COMPLETE THE APPLICATION

Qualifying homeowners will then be invited to complete the application in phases. At that time, supporting documentation will be required to verify eligibility for financial assistance.

All flood-impacted homeowners are strongly encouraged to complete the survey. Even if you don't think you will qualify now, you may qualify as more funding becomes available.
