RE: R.S 28:772 regional funding of addictive disorder services through federal block grant money obtained by the state

This report was created by the Office of Behavioral Health (OBH), with contributions from the Local Governing Entities (LGEs; also known as Human Service Districts or Authorities), in response to the requirements of Revised Statute 28:772. Section E of this statute states:

The secretary or assistant secretary of the department shall submit an annual report to each member of the legislature listing the contractors and the amounts such contractors received for the provision of regional addictive disorder services and services provided through grants which were received through application by the department or a regional office of the department.

OBH no longer has regional offices. Regional addictive disorder services are currently provided through LGEs. Some LGEs provide these services directly and therefore do not have or have fewer contractual relationships with providers and some LGEs contract with third party providers for all of this type of service. The attached listing reflects services provided through the LGEs' individual contracts with their providers supported with federal grant dollars that were received through application by OBH. The listing reflects the LGE, the contractor's name, facility description and location, the contract amount and type of services provided.
