





Forum Survey Respondents by Region and Industry





Review of Proposed Quality Measures

Summary of Performance Measure Changes (Handout)

- Performance measures set increased from 51 to 64 measures
- Incentivized measures were reduced from 16 to 12
- 10 new incentivized measures
- 9 current incentivized measures moved to monitored
- 3 incentivized measures moved to managed care incentive payment program
- Measures voted to be incentivized that were retired from national endorsement were not incentivized (eg. Ambulatory visits-ED visits)
- Some monitored measures to be stratified by race/ethnicity
