SUBJECT: Extension to Program Closures

On June 5, 2020, the State of Louisiana will move into Phase 2 of the Reopen America Plan, the Office for Citizens with Developmental Disabilities (OCDD) and the Office of Aging and Adult Services (OAAS) are extending statewide program closures for Adult Day Care centers, Adult Day Health Care centers, and Program for All-Inclusive Care of the Elderly (PACE) centers through Phase 2. To continue to protect the health and safety of individuals during the COVID-19 public health emergency, all ADC, ADHC and PACE providers shall **REMAIN CLOSED** through Phase 2 of the Reopen Plan. State Program Offices will provide further guidance about options for providers to deliver services during Phase 2. PACE centers may continue to operate as clinics following all applicable federal and state mandates relative to the COVID-19 public health emergency.

Each ADC, ADHC, and PACE provider shall immediately notify its participants and families of the updated center closure information.
