SUBJECT: COVID-19 Public Health Emergency ADHC Exceptions with End Dates

The COVID-19 Public Health Emergency will be ENDING 5/11/23. OAAS previously notified ADHC providers of the PHE exceptions with end dates on 4/24/23. ADHC Providers should review the attached updated "COVID-19 FAQ with End Dates Identified in RED" dated 5/10/2023.

ADHC providers should continue to retain appropriate documentation of any COVID-19 related funds that they receive through programs such as the U.S. Small Business Administration (SBA) Paycheck Protection Program (PPP), CARES Act Provider Relief Fund distributions, or other State or Federal grant/loan programs. Documentation should include, at a minimum, the total amount of revenue received, the percentage of revenue retained and the amount of the loan principal and interest forgiven. This guidance was provided to ADHC providers in the memorandum "Updates to ADHC Provider Regarding Payments and Tracking Due to COVID-19 Emergency" (OAAS-P-20-025) dated 6/1/20.

All exceptions, except the information in the above paragraph, will revert to pre-COVID-19 requirements after the end dates noted. The information with end dates in the COVID-19 FAQ, as well as this memo, supersedes any guidance previously provided in the following memorandums:

- OAAS-P-20-005 dated 5/20/20;
- OAAS-P-20-025 dated 6/1/20; and
- OAAS-P-20-032 dated 8/7/20.
