SUBJECT: Recommended ADC Closures Extended through February 14, 2021

The Office for Citizens with Developmental Disabilities (OCDD) is strongly encouraging ADC providers (those who were able to open when their parish COVID-19 positivity rate was 5% or below) to remain closed through **February 14, 2021**. This will allow time for the COVID-19 positivity rate in our state to drop, with a goal of getting the COVID-19 positivity rate below 5%. OCDD is aware that the majority of providers who were previously allowed to reopen remained closed during the month of January, and we believe that the continued closure of these agencies can help prevent the unintentional spread of COVID-19.
