OFFICIAL BIOGRAPHY

Dr. Evelyn Griffin is a board-certified obstetrician—gynecologist, credentialed by the American College of Obstetricians and Gynecologists, with additional certification by the Institute for Functional Medicine. Among the first robotically trained gynecologic surgeons in her region, she has extensive experience managing fibroids, endometriosis, and urogynecologic conditions.

In obstetrics, her work included a focus on reducing maternal morbidity and mortality, particularly related to hypertensive disorders and postpartum hemorrhage. She completed her medical degree at Ross University School of Medicine, followed by residency training in Obstetrics and Gynecology at Louisiana State University in New Orleans. She subsequently practiced for 15 years in a multispecialty clinic and hospital system and currently works as an obstetric hospitalist.

Recognizing escalating chronic disease among her patients, she launched a preventive health initiative to advance sustained disease prevention, and even reversal. In addition to her clinical work, she serves on the Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices (ACIP), providing guidance to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention.
