Do we need a separate budget for each program component or can the programs be combined within a single template?

A single budget that includes proposed costs for all program components is acceptable.

Which personnel fall into the administrative staff category?

Attached is an updated personnel table and the highlighted staff are considered to be administrative staff.

Which personnel fall into the direct services staff category?

Attached is an updated personnel table and the non-highlighted staff are considered to be direct services staff.

Will contractors be allowed to obtain a performance bond or an irrevocable letter of credit instead of having funds retained by the department?

No. The 10% retainage provided in ¶IV.C on p. 41 of the RFP is the sole method of ensuring the contractor's satisfactory performance of the contract services.

Are contractors required to have 24 months of experience in each of the program components to be considered eligible for funding?

No, contractors are not required to demonstrate 24 months of experience in each of the program components. Instead, they must be able to document that they have experience in administering, planning, and delivering HIV-related services and that they have completed a similar type project within the last 24 months as set forth in ¶III.O.6.a on p. 38 of the RFP.
