Dr. David Martin was appointed the Superintendent of the Louisiana Special School District on May 1, 2023 and is in his 14th year as a school administrator. Prior to accepting the position and moving to Louisiana, Dr. Martin served as the Superintendent of the Tennessee School for the Blind in Nashville. He has also been a principal and assistant principal with the Department of Defense Education Activity, serving military connected families both stateside and abroad. Dr. Martin began his career in education as a high school social studies teacher.

Dr. Martin has been a board member of the Council for the Schools and Services for the Blind for the past six years and a longtime member of the American Association of School Administrators. The AASA named Dr. Martin as one of 100 Leaders that Matter in 2019. He holds a doctorate degree in educational leadership, a specialist's degree in curriculum and instruction, master's degree in educational leadership, and bachelor's degree in political science. Dr. Martin also has completed a post graduate certificate in school leadership through a joint program with the Harvard Schools of Education and Business.
