4/29/2022 14:36	2022 - Amendment 14 - Amd 14 Attachment B14 - Changes to Statement of Work 4.25.2022	<p>Under no circumstances should the reduction or elimination of general liability insurance be allowed for transportation providers as it is a major risk to the Medicaid passengers in those vehicles. As the department may be aware, auto liability policies specifically exclude loading and unloading and anything related to the trip other than while physically in the car. Veyo, as a broker, has years of experience where a passenger may get injured while loading or unloading (falling off ramp or out of wheelchair) or the transporting entity injures a passenger while walking to the vehicle. Without the General Liability coverage, the passenger has no recourse with insurance protection and the provider can and does frequently go out of business to avoid a judgment. Reducing or eliminating the GL coverage is a major risk for patients and should not be allowed here. Thank you for considering our comments.</p>
