Request for Tribal Comments July 20, 2018

<u>Managed Care for Physical and Behavioral Health – Skilled Nursing Facility Services</u> Effective date: October 20, 2018

The purpose of this SPA is to amend the provisions governing managed care for physical and behavioral health in order to allow managed care organizations to utilize skilled nursing facilities for members who transition from acute care hospital services as a step-down continuum of care and to align the governing authorities with current operations and practices.

<u>Federally Qualified Health Centers - Reimbursement Methodology -Long-Acting Reversible Contraceptives</u>

Effective date: January 1, 2019

The purpose of this SPA is to amend the provisions governing the reimbursement methodology for federally qualified health centers in order to implement a payment methodology to allow reimbursement for long-acting reversible contraceptive devices outside of the perspective payment system rate.

Effective date: January 1, 2019
