Request for Tribal Comments September 20, 2019

<u>Disproportionate Share Hospital Payments – Major Medical Centers</u> Effective date: January 1, 2020

The purpose of this SPA is to establish a qualification criteria and disproportionate share hospital (DSH) payment methodology for major medical centers located in the southeastern area of Louisiana.

<u>Inpatient Hospital Services – Non-Rural, Non-State Hospitals – Reimbursement Rate</u> Effective date: January 1, 2020

The purpose of this SPA is to amend the provisions governing the reimbursement methodology for inpatient hospital services in order to adjust the reimbursement rates.

<u>Outpatient Hospital Services – Non-Rural, Non-State Hospitals – Reimbursement Rate</u> Effective date: January 1, 2020

The purpose of this SPA is to amend the provisions governing the reimbursement methodology for outpatient hospital services in order to adjust the reimbursement rates.
