## **State Plan Amendments for Submittal to CMS**

Request for Tribal Comments June 6, 2025

Personal Care Services – Long Term Effective date: April 1, 2025

The purpose of this SPA is to amend the provisions governing personal care services (PCS), in order make the reimbursement rate currently paid to PCS direct service workers under the Home and Community Based Services Waiver CMS-approved Spending Plan, part of the permanent State Plan.

The reimbursement rate for PCS shall be increased by \$4.50 per hour. The minimum hourly rate paid to PCS direct service workers (DSW) shall be at least \$9 per hour, regardless of full-time or part-time status. All PCS providers affected by the \$4.50 per hour rate increase shall pass 70 percent of their rate increases directly to the DSW in various forms, including a minimum wage floor of \$9 per hour and wage and non-wage benefits for all affected DSWs, regardless of full-time or part-time status.
