

Chisholm Class Members and Healthy Louisiana

Chisholm class members are Medicaid recipients ages 3-20 on the Developmental Disabilities Request for Services Registry (“the registry”).

For most of your Medicaid services (not transportation or behavioral health), you can pick:

- Regular Medicaid (“Fee-For-Service”) or
- A Healthy Louisiana health plan.

Picking a Healthy Louisiana health plan for all of your Medicaid services is called “opt-in.”

To Opt-in to Healthy Louisiana for Physical Health Services:

Call Healthy Louisiana at 1-855-229-6848 or go online at www.myplan.healthy.la.gov.

You must sign up by the 2nd to last workday of the month for your new plan to start on the first of the next month. Example: If you want your new health plan to start on October 1, 2025, you must make the change before 6 p.m. on September 29, 2025. If you make the change after September 29 your new health plan will start on November 1, 2025.

To Leave Healthy Louisiana (Go Back to Medicaid Fee-for-Service) for Physical Health Services:

Chisholm class members can switch back to Medicaid Fee-for-Service for their physical health services at any time. Behavioral health and transportation will stay with your health plan.

Like joining, changes always begin on the 1st of the month. You must make the change by the 2nd to last workday of the month for Fee-for-Service to start the following month. Example: If you want Fee-for-Service to start on October 1, 2025, you must make the change before 6 p.m. on September 29, 2025. If you make the change after September 29 Fee-for-Service will start on November 1, 2025.

Important: If you leave Healthy Louisiana, you can only sign up again during the annual open enrollment period.

Note: Children in the Act 421 Children’s Medicaid Option must have a Healthy Louisiana health plan for all of their Medicaid services.
