## Database Clean Up Overview

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The Database Clean Up suite of programs (MEL\*) is designed to allow a user to quickly remove the MEDS data created from trainees executing the training exercises. The MEDS data (for each of the Last Names provided) will be completely removed from the system, the end result being an initialized training database ready for the next group of trainees.

## Database Clean Up Process

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The Database Clean Up process consists of the following 5 steps:

- Last Name Entry (Initial Set Up)
- Database Clean Up Initiation (CLEANUP)
- Person Information Purge
- Case Information Purge
- User Confirmation

Each one of the steps is described in detail below.

## *Last Name Entry (Initial Set Up)*

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The Last Names to be deleted must be defined in a TSO dataset called "ME.METRAIN.LAST.NAMES". Getting access to this dataset and how to update it is outside of the scope of this document – please contact the IS dept for help.

## Database Clean Up Initiation (CLEANUP)

MEDS transaction id "**CLEANUP**" will initiate the Database Clean Up process. It may be entered from any MEDS screen that allows entry of the "\*Tran" (Transaction Id) field on the Direct Command line.

## *Person Information Purge*

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Each MEDS Person identified from the Last Name list will be purged, along with all other Person related information (e.g., Person Income, Person Lock-In, etc.). In addition, all Cases with Case Members to be purged are identified and collected for the Case Information Purge process.

## *Case Information Purge*

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Each Case identified in the Person Information Purge process will be purged, along with all other Case related information (e.g., Applications, Determinations, Budgets, etc.).

## *User Confirmation*

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The completion of the batch process can be confirmed in 2 ways:

- Reviewing the JOB (JOB Name: MECLEANU) in TSO.
- Searching MEDS (using PERQN) for the last existing Last Name supplied in the ME.METRAIN.LAST.NAMES dataset. When this name is no longer displayed, the batch job has finished.
