User ID & Password

Users must log in at least once a month to either CASPER Reporting or the QIES User Maintenance application in order to keep their User IDs active.

Beginning 7/12/2010 users who have not logged into either CASPER Reporting or the QIES User Maintenance application will be unable to submit MDS assessments and access Final Validation Reports."

Notice: MDS Personal Login ID Requirement

A MDS Personal Login ID is required in order to access the MDS Submission System and CASPER Reports. In order to acquire a Personal Login ID, a request must be submitted to the Help Desk. A link to the MDS Personal Login ID forms can be found on the QIES Technical Support Office website https://www.qtso.com/accessmds.html. Forms will be processed within 5 business days.

After you receive your new MDS personal login ID, login to the QIES User Maintenance Application using the link on the MDS State Welcome Page. When you login you will enter

answers to security questions, as well as, create a personal, secure password. The answers you enter for the security questions can be used to securely identify you in the event that you need to reset a forgotten password or reset an inactive account.

Dear Cindy:

- Q: Is it true that assessments must be transmitted within 14 days of the completion date with MDS 3.0?
- A: Yes, assessments must be transmitted within 14 days of the completion date.
- Q: When is the first MDS 3.0 assessment due?
- A: When the ARD is 10/1/2010 or after, an MDS 3.0 is required.

Expired Password Enforcement use pa

Beginning July 12, 2010, MDS individual user IDs with an expired password will be unable to access the MDS

Submission System. The change to enforce expired passwords is being introduced as a part of the ongoing effort to ensure ARS (Acceptable Risk Safeguard) security compliance. The implementation date for Expired MDS Individual

User ID Password Enforcement will be early morning Wednesday August 18, 2010. Downtime is expected to be minimal and access to the MDS Submission System
