## State of Louisiana COVID-19 Vaccination Medical Risk Factor Self-Attestation Form

Effective Monday, February 22<sup>,</sup> the State of Louisiana has expanded eligibility for COVID-19 Vaccines to include people who have health conditions that may result in a higher risk of disease. If you are between the ages of 55 and 64 (everyone 65 and older is already eligible) **and** have one of the following conditions, you are now eligible to receive COVID-19 vaccine. If you are pregnant regardless of age you are eligible.

**Please check next to the high-risk medical condition that you have** and sign at the bottom of the form. The vaccination site will keep a copy of this form, and it may be audited by the State. If able, please bring this (or a copy) form to your vaccination appointment. No other documentation from your doctor is needed.

## <u>High-risk medical conditions (aged 55 and up) now eligible in Phase 1b. Check all that apply:</u>

- o Cancer
- o Chronic kidney disease
- o COPD (chronic obstructive pulmonary disease)
- o Down Syndrome
- o Heart conditions, such as heart failure, coronary artery disease or cardiomyopathies
- o Immunocompromised state (weakened immune system) from solid organ transplant
- Obesity (body mass index [BMI] of 30kg/m<sup>2</sup> or higher but < 40kg/m<sup>2</sup>)
- Severe obesity (BMIC >40kg/m²)
- Pregnancy
- Sickle Cell Disease
- Smoking
- o Type 2 diabetes mellitus
