## **IMPORTANT NOTE REGARDING BinaxNOW COVID-19 Antigen Test SUPPLIES**

The Louisiana Office of Public Health (OPH) has been notified of a potential issue with BinaxNOW COVID-19 Antigen tests involving the positive control devices included in test kits. We do not, at this time, believe there is an issue with the test cards—only the controls. We are working with Abbott's Quality Assurance team to investigate the issue.

## As a friendly reminder.

- Positive Controls should be run with each new lot number, new shipment and when training new personnel.
- Per the BinaxNOW procedure, you need to use 8 drops of reagent when conducting a positive control (as opposed to 6 drops when running patient samples).
