## Louisiana Office of Public Health COVID-19 Testing Criteria Update

The Louisiana Office of Public Health (OPH) Laboratory has the capacity to conduct laboratory testing for SARS-CoV-2, the virus that causes coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19). As of March 6, 2020, the criteria for SARS-CoV-2 testing through the OPH Laboratory has been expanded. SARS-CoV-2 testing is now available for non-hospitalized patients with clinical features consistent with COVID-19 who also have a recent travel history to an area with sustained community transmission of COVID-19. **Approval for testing must be obtained from the Infectious Disease Epidemiology Section (800-256-2748) prior to sample submission.** 

The testing criteria below are subject to change according to the availability of laboratory testing and updated epidemiologic information. Testing of samples for non-hospitalized patients may be delayed according to the volume of samples and changes in testing availability.

## Criteria to Guide Evaluation of Persons Under Investigation for COVID-19

Clinical Features	&	Epidemiologic Risk
Fever1 <b>or</b> signs/symptoms of lower respiratory illness (e.g. cough or shortness of breath)	AND	Close contact with a laboratory-confirmed COVID-19 patient within 14 days of symptom onset
Fever1 <b>and</b> signs/symptoms of a lower respiratory illness (e.g., cough or shortness of breath)	AND	A history of travel from affected geographic areas2 within 14 days of symptom onset
Fever1 with severe acute lower respiratory illness (e.g., pneumonia, ARDS [acute respiratory distress syndrome]) requiring hospitalization and without alternative explanatory diagnosis (e.g., influenza)	AND	No identified source of exposure

1Measured as  $\ge$  100.4°F.

2Affected geographic areas are defined as countries assigned a level 2 or 3 travel health notice by CDC or other areas determined to have sustained community transmission.

The availability of diagnostic testing for COVID-19 through commercial laboratories is increasing. Providers should immediately report positive COVID-19 commercial laboratory results laboratory results to the Infectious Disease Epidemiology Section at 800-256-2748.
