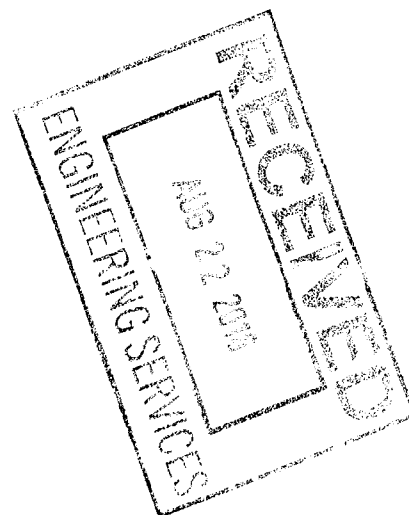

Dear Mr. Nolan,

In a letter from you dated July 13, 2016 regarding the above subject matter, the Louisiana Department of Health (LDH) requested for public water systems to provide the following information either through their own publicly accessible website or through LDH's website:

*Materials inventory of the distribution system previously required to complete under the LCR. This inventory must include the locations of lead service lines, together with any updates to the inventory and map(s) of lead service lines and lead plumbing in the system.

The letter also indicated that the information requested above should be posted on the water system's website or submitted to LDH by August 31, 2016.

This letter is to notify you that as of August 4, 2016, Lafayette Utilities Water System has posted the following statement on our website at WWW.lus.org in compliance with your request:

"Based upon a materials inventory and investigation first conducted in 1991, LUS has no records or information indicating that there are any lines in its water distribution system containing lead."
