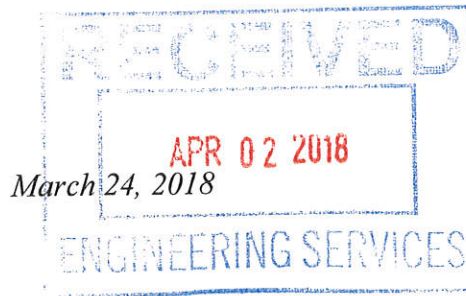

This correspondence is in response to your request for a materials inventory that reports locations of lead service lines within our water system.

I have queered our longtime operators (some with experience of over 20 years); the Public Works Superintendent (with experience of over 30 years), and our City Engineer (with experience with the City for over 40 years), in regards to any knowledge of lead service lines within our system. None of those questioned have ever seen lead service lines on our system. That is not to say that there may be some isolated locations in the older sections of our water system that may have lead service lines, but we know of no known specific locations.

We hope that this report assist your office in your development of a reporting system as to known issues of lead service lines.
