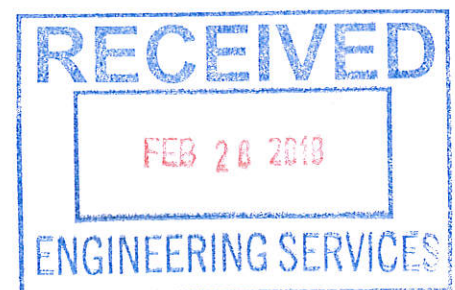

(A representative site is a site in which the plumbing materials used at that site would be commonly found at other sites served by the water system.)

By sampling Tier 2, Tier 3 or Representative locations, the water system is certifying that all available Tier 1 locations have been used for sampling event.
