Important: You are responsible for the <u>accuracy</u> of your applications and accompanying documentation. The accuracy of your documents affects the processing time. Your legal first and last names MUST appear the <u>same</u> on <u>ALL</u> documents (Double check the spelling of your name). Do <u>not</u> make any changes to the endorsement(s) and/or insurance documents. If changes are needed on the proof of insurance, then contact the insurance company.

A completed and signed Basic License Application form. All fields and signatures are mandatory. IF YOU PROVIDE AN EMAIL ADDRESS, IT WILL BE THE METHOD USED TO CONTACT YOU.
A completed and signed Affidavit. All fields and signatures are mandatory.
A <u>completed</u> and <u>signed</u> Combination License Application form. <u>All fields and signatures are mandatory</u> .
Original endorsement(s) from a licensed manufacturer(s) for the brand(s) of individual mechanical plant to be installed/maintained, <u>signed if required</u> . (For endorsements which state maintenance/service only, a Maintenance License must be acquired.)
Proof of insurance in the form of a certificate of insurance (COI), or the declaration, that provides the name of the installer and the Certificate Holder information as follows: LDH-OPH, Onsite Wastewater Program Bin 10 Box 11, P. O. Box 4489, Baton Rouge, LA 70821. The policy shall indicate minimum coverage limits of at least \$100,000 each occurrence/\$300,000 aggregate per person.
NOTE: Your insurance policy must have your name on it as we do not issue installer licenses to companies.
Check or money order, payable to LDH/OPH for two hundred dollars, U.S. \$200.00 (includes basic fee.) If applying for all three licenses (basic, combination and maintenance), your total fees are \$300.00.
PLEASE NOTE: All application materials for license renewals are due by December 1st. LATE FEEs in the amount of 10% of the licensing fees will be assessed if all materials for licensure have no been postmarked by December 31st. Any application materials postmarked later than March 3rd will result in the applicant being assessed a fine of 100% of the cost of licensure. LATE FEES must be paid by separate check or money order. License renewal application packets will not be processed if LATE FEES are due and the applicant fails to submit the applicable LATE FEES IN FULL (authorized by L.R.S. 40:6.E).
Also, if your training has expired, please contact ULL at (337) 482-5712 or you can now register online at www.ce.louisiana.edu to enroll in the next available class. Training is <u>required</u> once every five years.
