**REOPENING OF  
MOLLUSCAN SHELLFISH GROWING WATERS IN LOUISIANA**

Pursuant to the provisions of LSA RS 40:5.3, as amended and re-enacted by Act 1 of the First Regular Legislative Session of 1988, and RS 40:5, the Precautionary Closure, due to effects from Hurricane Ida, of molluscan shellfish growing areas 9 and 10 is hereby RESCINDED.

Open areas shall revert back to the September - October 2021 seasonal classification effective at official sunrise, Wednesday, September 22, 2021.


Areas 1, 2, 6, 7, 8, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, 18, 19, 20, 21, 22, 23, 24, 25, 26, 27, and 28 shall remain CLOSED due to adverse conditions from Hurricane Ida. Reopening of these shellfish harvest areas will be conducted as soon as it is determined that environmental conditions are within the requirements specified by the National Shellfish Sanitation Program.

This order is effective at official sunrise, September 22, 2021.
