Help with Transportation to Appointments

for Children with Special Health Care Needs

Children and youth with special health care needs usually have to see more than one doctor. These appointments are important for a child's health but may be hard for some families to get to. Transportation shouldn't be a barrier to health, and Louisiana provides options to help families get to medical appointments.

Request Transportation Assistance for the Medical Appointment

If you need help getting your child to a doctor's appointment, the first thing to do is to call your Medicaid provider. They can arrange travel and cover the transportation needs for most families. Here is the contact information for current Medicaid providers:

What to Do if Your Request is Denied?

Sometimes Medicaid won't cover a request for transportation. If your request is denied, ask your Medicaid organization for the "Trip Denial Reference Number." Families Helping Families may be able to help you pay for transportation when this happens.

If your child meets the eligibility requirements listed below, you may be able to get some or all of your transportation costs covered, so long as the transportation is for medical appointments or other medically necessary services.

To get transportation help through Families Helping Families, the child must:

- Live in Louisiana
- Be under age 21
- Have Medicaid or meet Children Special Health Services (CSHS) income rules (call for more information on income rules)
- Have a health condition that CSHS covers (visit <u>Idh.la.gov/cshs</u> for more info)
