QUESTION OF THE WEEK:

What are the symptoms of an allergic reaction to the vaccine? What should I do if I have a reaction after getting the vaccine?

Although rare, allergic reactions are possible. It is for this reason that everyone who is vaccinated is observed for 15 minutes after getting the shot. Individuals who alert the vaccine team that they have allergies must be observed for 30 minutes. Common reactions include flushing, rapid heartbeat, and shortness of breath. If you have an allergic reaction after leaving the vaccination site, you should contact your medical provider or seek emergency care if severe. If you have a severe reaction, call 911. WEEKLY COVID-19 VACCINE UPDATE

Here is an overview of major updates that occurred over the week.

Pfizer-BioNtech Accounts for 6th Dose

The U.S. government currently funds 6 doses per vial, and updated ancillary kits already provide a mix of syringes that support providers extracting 6 doses per vial. The change will be implemented **on Tuesday**, **February 16, 2021.** Providers will need to enter all 6 doses in LINKS after administering the vaccine. If the vaccination provider cannot pull 6 doses from the vial, the 6th dose will need to be entered as wasted. VACCINE DOSES ADMINISTERED IN LOUISIANA


Have a Safer Valentine's Day
