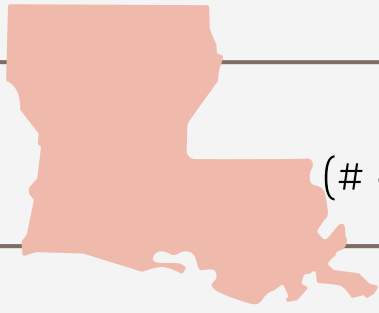

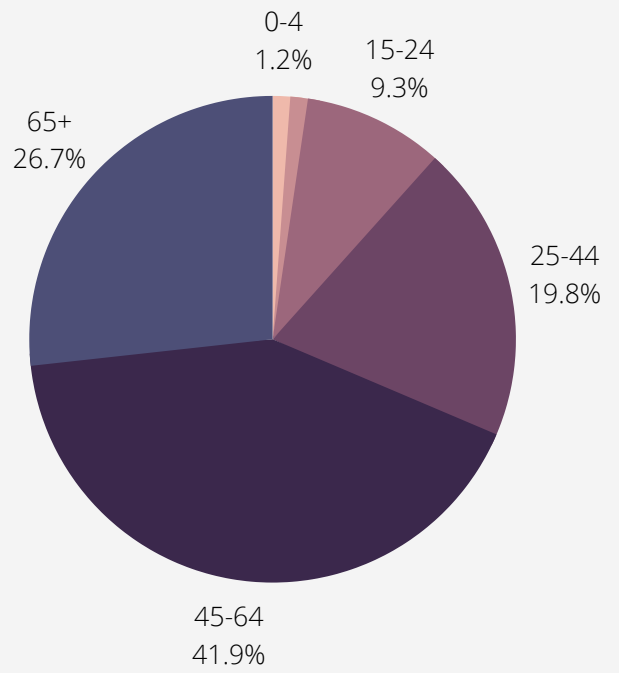
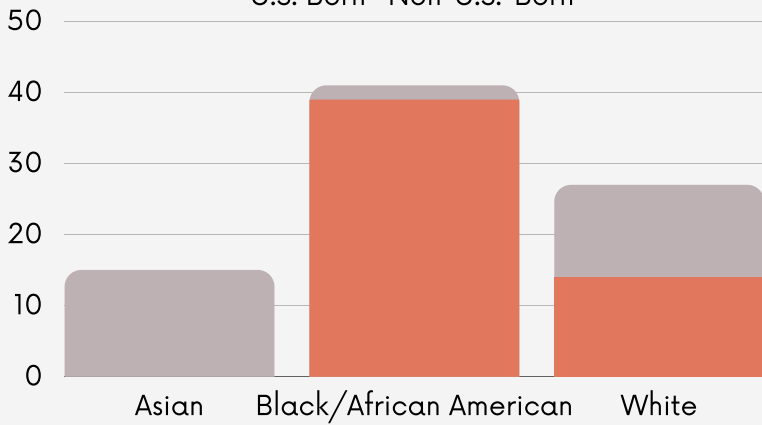
DEMOGRAPHICS

• U.S. Born • Non-U.S.-Born



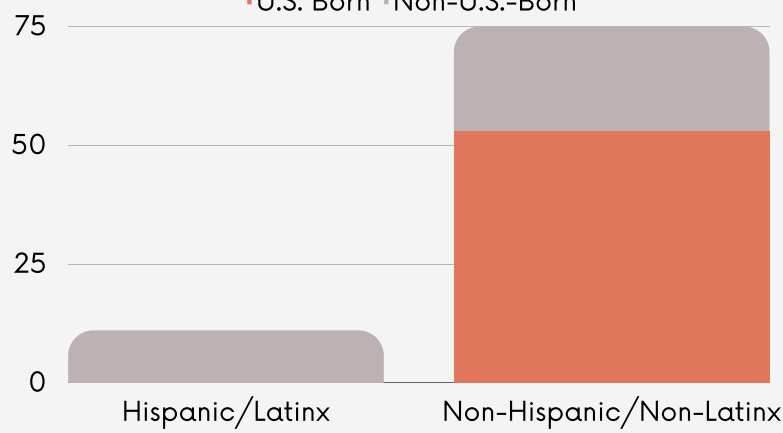
70.9% of TB cases identified as male

The majority of TB cases identified as Non-Hispanic/Non-Latinx

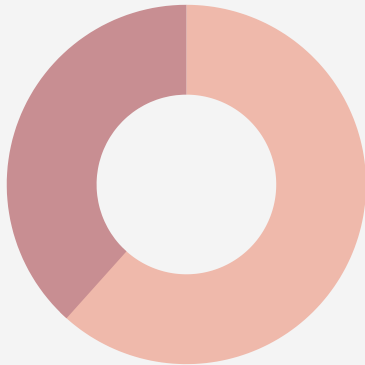

COUNTRY OF ORIGIN

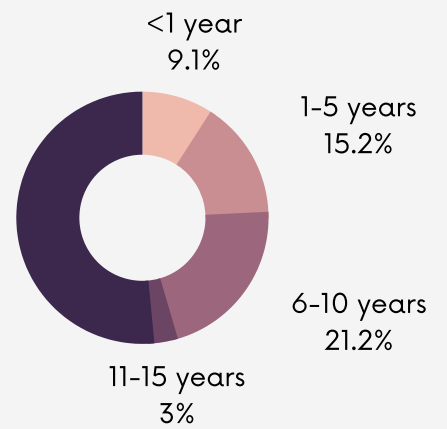
Non-U.S.-Born TB Cases represented 14 countries, primarily Honduras and Vietnam

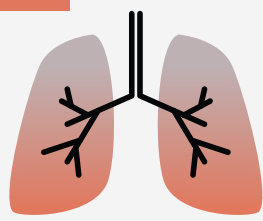

70% Pulmonary

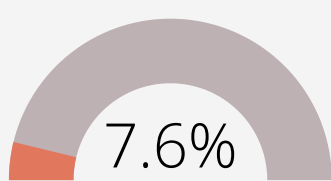


DIAGNOSTICS

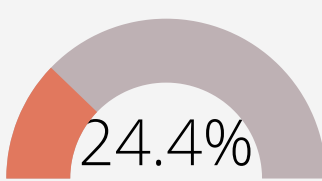
64% of TB cases were initially evaluated because they had TB symptoms

86% of TB cases had culture confirmed diagnosis

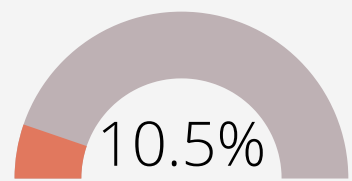

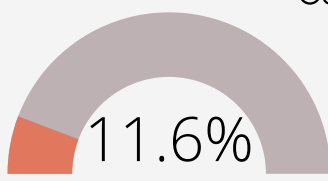
HIV Co-Infection



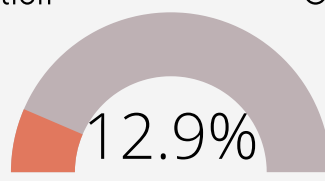
Diabetes Co-Infection
