

LOUISIANA SCHOOL-BASED HEALTH CENTER REGISTRY

Act 318 of the 2023 Regular Session of the Louisiana Legislature requires the Louisiana Department of Health (LDH), Office of Public Health (OPH) to create a registry for health centers in schools, also known as school-based health centers (SBHCs). In response, OPH has created a survey for all health centers in schools to complete registration.

Initial registration is required with OPH by June 30, 2024.

This survey and the registry are only for SBHCs providing services to students in elementary, middle, and high schools. Health centers will be required to register annually.
