BECOME A FAMILY LEADER

Family Leaders are the legal and primary guardians of a child in Louisiana who want to share their experiences with developmental and caregiver depression screenings during well-child visits.

They will work with Project SOAR (Screen Often and Accurately Refer) to increase the chances that children and parents receive equitable, timely, and accurate screening and follow-up to make a positive difference in the lives of families across the state.

WHO CAN BE A PROJECT SOAR FAMILY LEADER?

Parenting caregivers in Louisiana with a child under age 5 who have:

- Gone to check-up visits with their child.
- At least 4-5 hours a month to participate virtually.
- Access to stable internet or a smartphone.

WHY BE A PROJECT SOAR FAMILY LEADER?

Through Project SOAR, Family Leaders will:

- Get paid for their time and expertise.
- Help improve early childhood healthcare.
- Improve and gain new leadership skills.
