What Is a Commemorative Birth Certificate?

An optional decorative version of an official Louisiana birth certificate, specially designed for display and remembrance.

Available for newborns, children, and adults, it is a meaningful keepsake that can be treasured for generations.

Bears the signatures of the Governor, First Lady, and Secretary of the Louisiana Department of Health, along with the Seal of the State of Louisiana
