

WHO IS ELIGIBLE FOR A BOOSTER?

What did you get?	When can you get a booster?	Who is eligible for a booster?
PFIZER/ COMIRNATY	<i>5 months after 2nd dose</i>	<i>12 years and older</i>
MODERNA	<i>5 months after 2nd dose</i>	<i>18 years and older</i>
JOHNSON & JOHNSON	<i>2 months after 2nd dose</i>	<i>18 years and older</i>

Louisianans ages 12 to 17 years old are eligible for the Pfizer booster only. Louisianans age 18 and older may choose which vaccine they want for a booster, even if it is different from the original vaccine received. Use of an mRNA COVID-19 vaccine (Moderna or Pfizer) for a booster dose is preferred even for those who had initially received the J&J COVID-19 vaccine.

Immunocompromised individuals age 5 and older who have completed an mRNA series at least 28 days ago can receive an additional dose of the appropriate COVID-19 vaccine.
