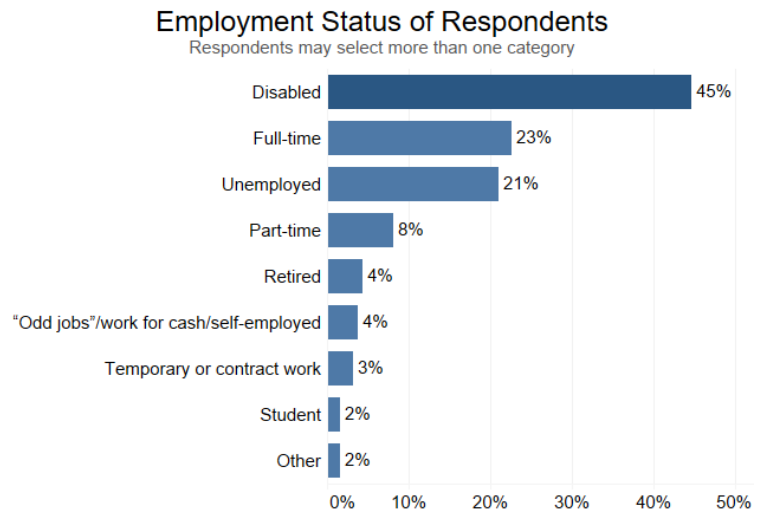
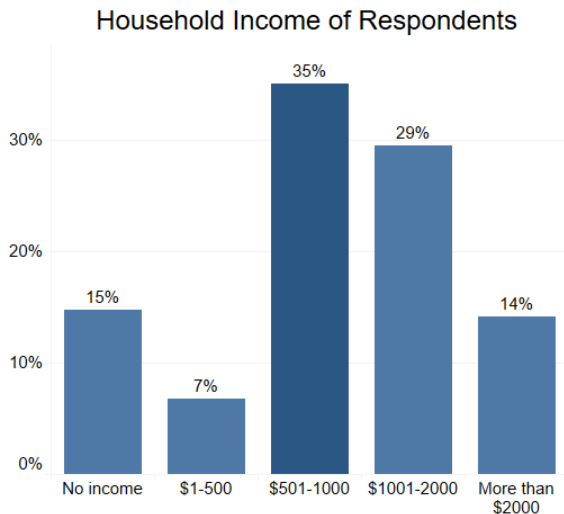
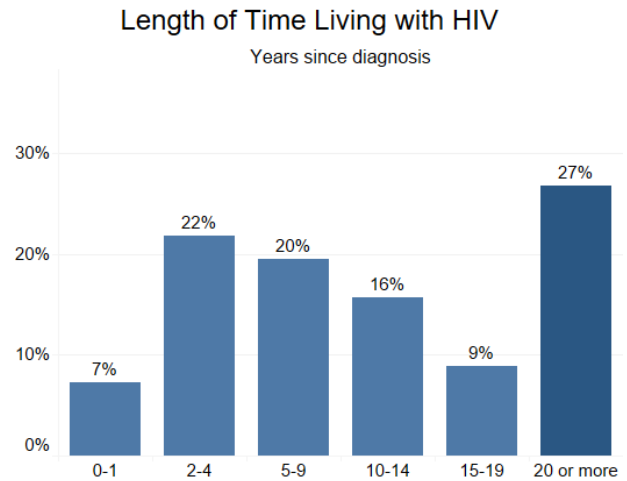
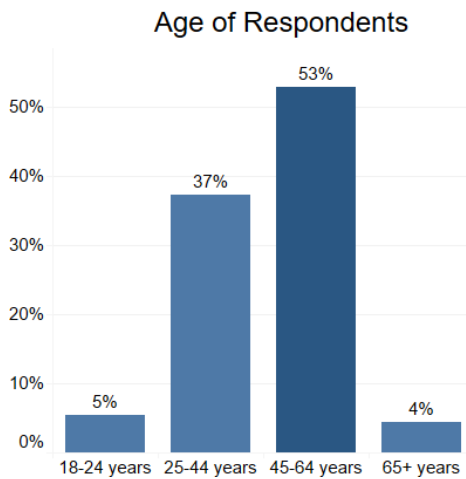
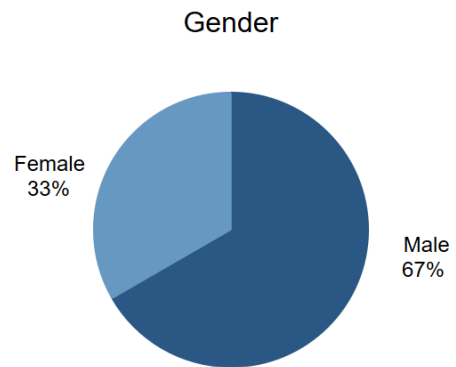
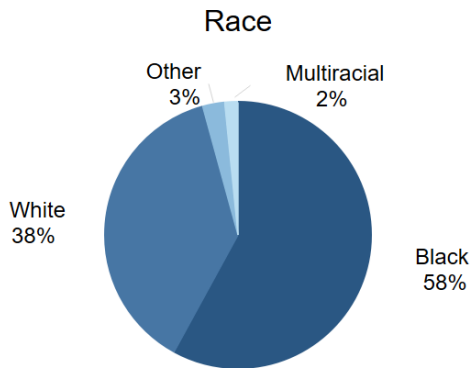


2019 Needs Assessment for Part B CBO Region 4

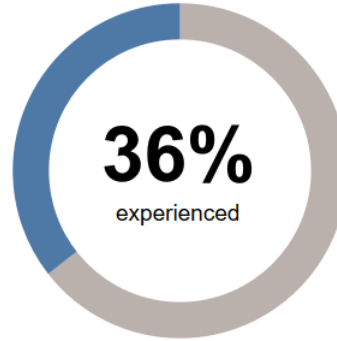

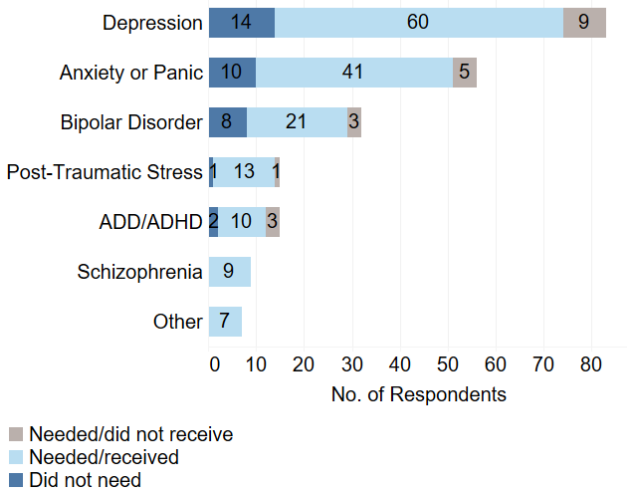
Mental Health

Feeling down, depressed, or hopeless Little interest or pleasure in doing things

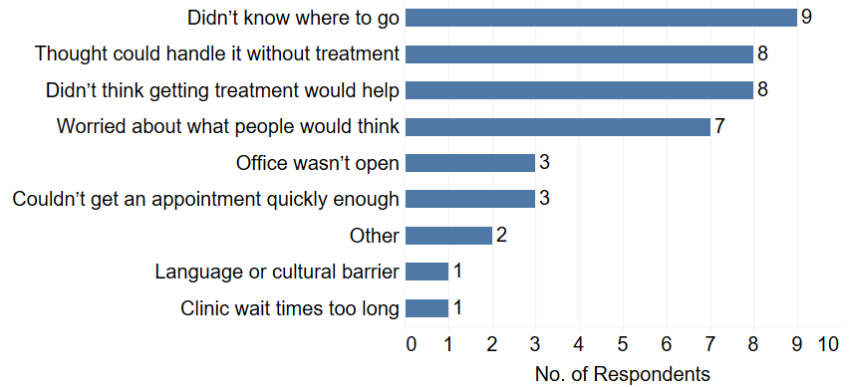


Mental Health Diagnoses



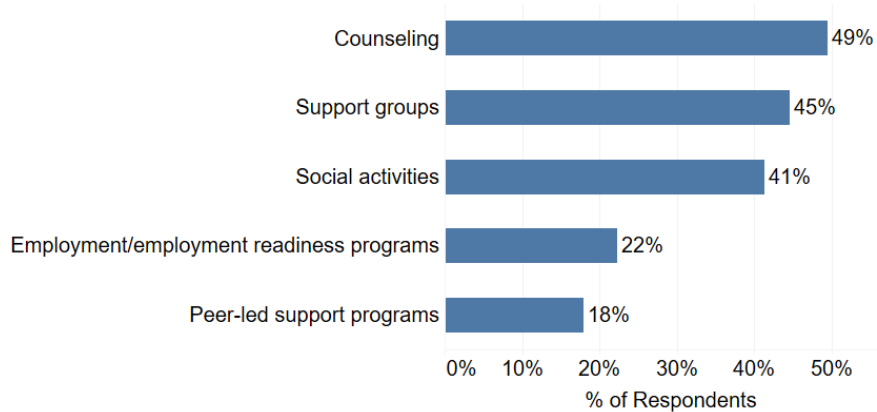
Reasons for Not Receiving Needed Mental Healthcare

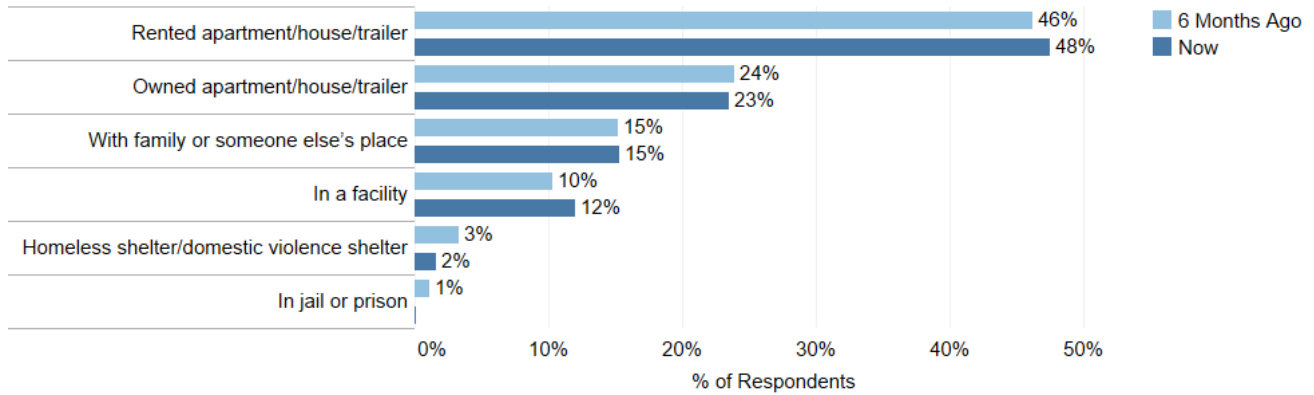

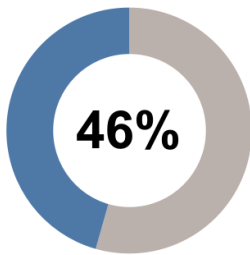

Housing at the Time of Survey and 6 Months Prior to Survey

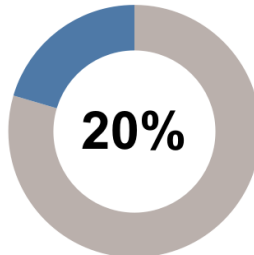


Percent of Respondents Who Report They Had...

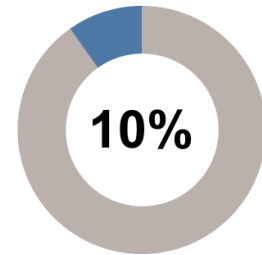
Difficulty in Paying Rent, Mortgage, or Utility Bills in the Past Year



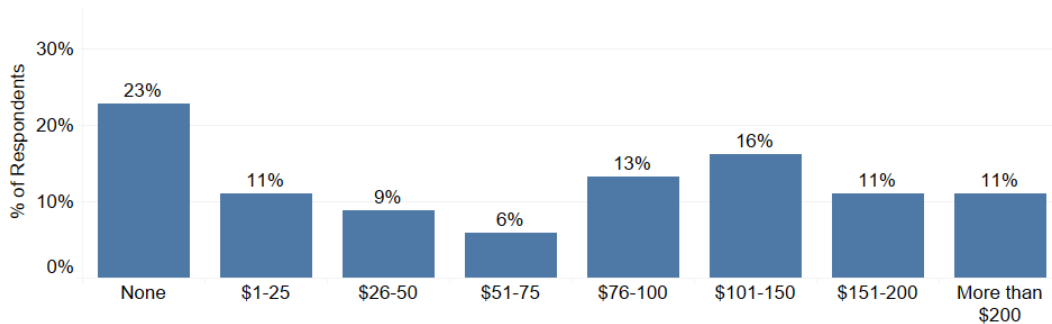
To Move in the Past 3 Years Because They Could No Longer Afford Housing
