Surveillance Summary

Data in this report includes cases diagnosed with HIV/AIDS and reported as of December 31, 2012¹.

- Nationally, Louisiana ranked 4th highest in AIDS case rates and 11th in the number of AIDS cases diagnosed in 2010, according to the *CDC 2010 HIV Surveillance Report (Vol. 22)*. The 2011 CDC report will be released in the Spring of 2013.
- Baton Rouge ranked 1st for AIDS case rates among the largest metropolitan areas in the U.S. in 2010; New Orleans ranked 5th.
- A total of **18,864** persons are living with HIV/AIDS in Louisiana; of these individuals, **10,380** persons (55%) have an AIDS diagnosis.
- Among women living with HIV/AIDS, the predominant known mode of transmission is high-risk heterosexual contact followed by injection drug use. Among men living with HIV/AIDS, the predominant mode of transmission is men who have sex with men followed by injection drug use.
- The primary risk factor for new HIV diagnoses in Louisiana is men who have sex with men (MSM). In 2011, of the persons who reported a risk factor, **59%** reported being MSM, and an additional **2%** reported being MSM and an injection drug user (IDU). As of December 31, 2012, **50%** of all people living with HIV infection in Louisiana were MSM.
- In 2011, **1,247** new HIV cases were diagnosed in Louisiana. Of these cases, **34%** (n=421) occurred in Region 1 (New Orleans) and **24%** (n=298) occurred in Region 2 (Baton Rouge).
- In 2011, **787** new AIDS cases were diagnosed in Louisiana. Of these cases, **33%** (n=259) occurred in Region 1 (New Orleans) and **28%** (n=219) occurred in Region 2 (Baton Rouge).
- In Louisiana, 30% of new HIV cases and 28% of new AIDS cases are among women.
- HIV continues to disproportionately affect African Americans in Louisiana. In 2011, 74% of newly diagnosed HIV cases and 76% of newly diagnosed AIDS cases were among African Americans.
- A large percentage of new diagnoses occurred among adolescents and young adults. In 2011, **26%** of all new HIV diagnoses occurred among persons 13-24 years old and an additional **30%** occurred among persons 25-34 years old.
- As of December 31, 2012, a cumulative total of **33,189** HIV/AIDS cases have been reported in Louisiana, including **336** pediatric cases.
- The cumulative number of deaths among persons diagnosed with HIV/AIDS, reported to the Louisiana Office of Public Health through December 31, 2012, is **14,112** including **111** deaths among pediatric cases.


