



Louisiana Health Access Program Statewide Quarterly Report April 01, 2018 - June 30, 2018

ENROLLMENT SUMMARY

During the quarter, 3,828 clients were enrolled in the Louisiana Health Access Program (LA HAP) of which 4% (n=149) were first time enrollees.

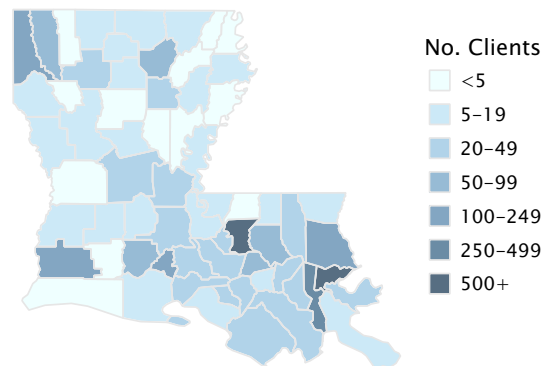
There were 89 clients who disenrolled from the program.

A total of 289 clients enrolled in the program to receive health insurance assistance who had previously been receiving uninsured assistance during the quarter.

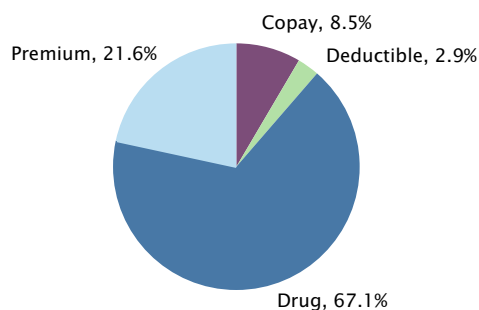
There were 75 clients enrolled in the program to receive uninsured assistance only who had previously been insured during the quarter.

The majority of LA HAP clients live in the New Orleans and Baton Rouge regions, 38% (n=1,448) and 25% (n=976) respectively.

UTILIZATION SUMMARY

LA HAP assisted with 40,856 claims including 27,397 (67%) drug claims, 3,459 (8%) copays, 1,174 (3%) deductibles and 8,826 (22%) premiums. Of these, 39,152 (96%) were for insured claims and 1,704 (4%) were for uninsured claims.

There were an average of 12.6 claims per person.

There were 2,884 clients who utilized health insurance assistance and 389 clients who utilized uninsured assistance.

CLINICAL OUTCOMES SUMMARY

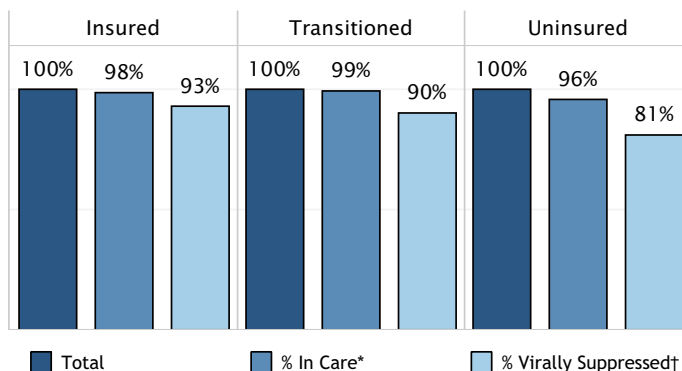
Nearly all clients (98%, n=3,758) were defined as in care. These clients had at least one CD4 or viral load test reported in the past year.

91% (n=3,501) of clients were virally suppressed. These clients had a viral load test reported in the past year with the most recent result <200 copies/mL.

Clients who are insured are more likely to be virally suppressed compared to those clients who are uninsured; 93% (n=2,831) of insured clients were virally suppressed compared to 81% (n=368) of uninsured clients.

The regions with the highest percentage of clients virally suppressed were Baton Rouge (94%) and Alexandria (94%).

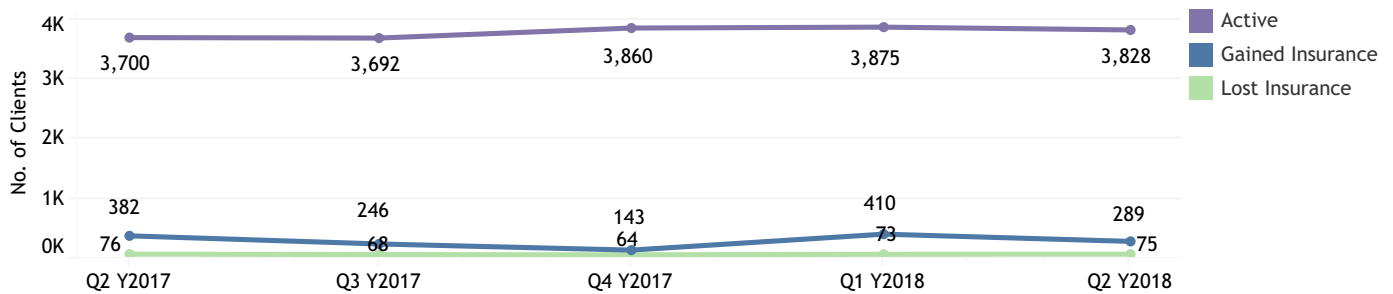

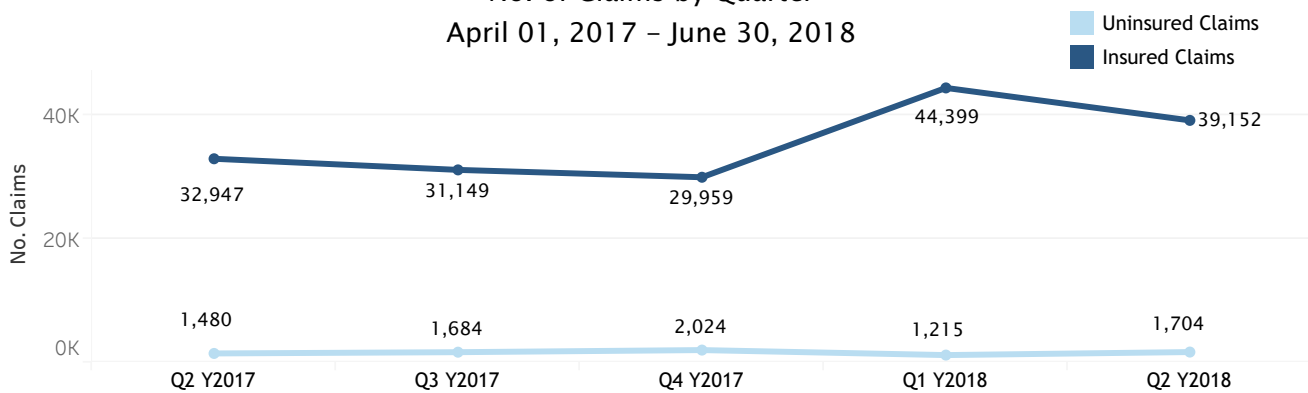

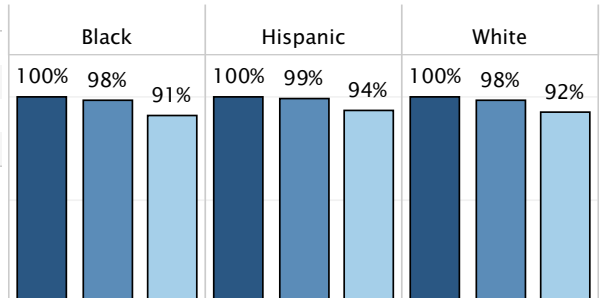

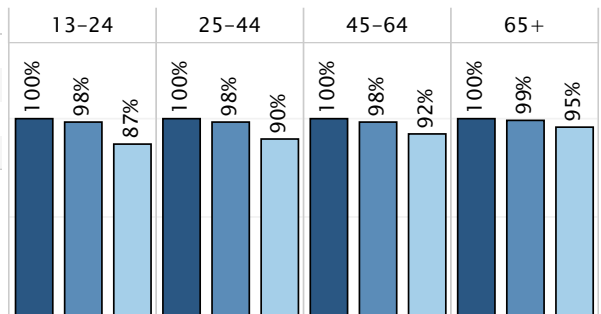

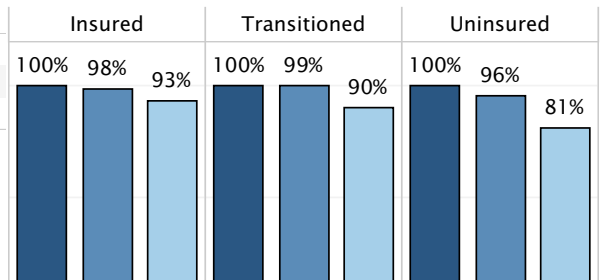

ENROLLMENT SUMMARY

During the quarter, 1,448 clients were enrolled in the Louisiana Health Access Program (LA HAP) of which 4% (n=52) were first time enrollees.

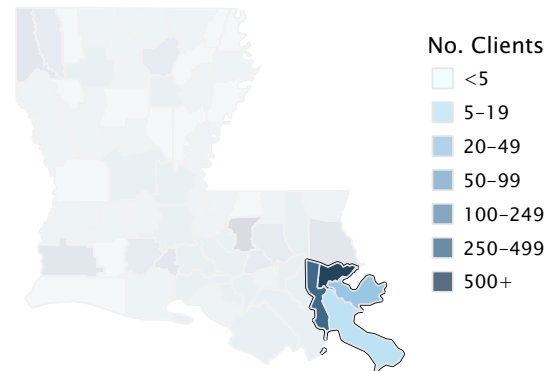
There were 28 clients who disenrolled from the program.

A total of 108 clients enrolled in the program to receive health insurance assistance who had previously been receiving uninsured assistance during the quarter.

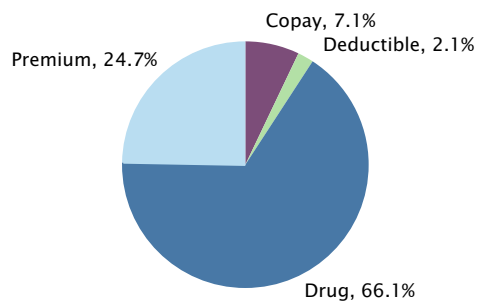
There were 23 clients enrolled in the program to receive uninsured assistance only who had previously been insured during the quarter.

The largest number of clients enrolled in LA HAP reside in the New Orleans Region.

UTILIZATION SUMMARY

LA HAP assisted with 14,708 claims including 9,725 (66%) drug claims, 1,041 (7%) copays, 309 (2%) deductibles and 3,633 (25%) premiums. Of these, 14,084 (96%) were for insured claims and 624 (4%) were for uninsured claims.

There were an average of 12.3 claims per person.

There were 1,071 clients who utilized health insurance assistance and 140 clients who utilized uninsured assistance.

36% of all LA HAP claims were for clients from the New Orleans Region.

CLINICAL OUTCOMES SUMMARY

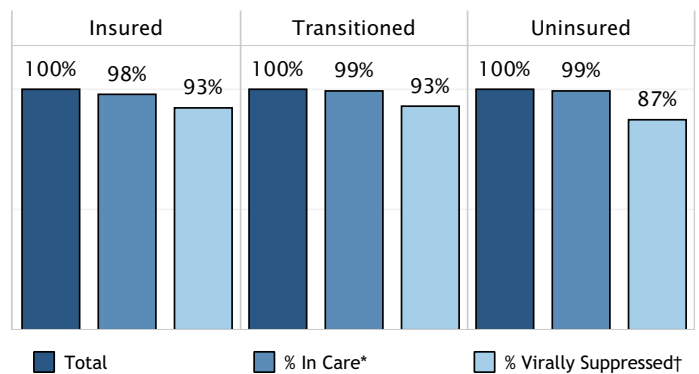
Nearly all clients (98%, n=1,423) were defined as in care. These clients had at least one CD4 or viral load test reported in the past year.

92% (n=1,333) of clients were virally suppressed. These clients had a viral load test reported in the past year with the most recent result <200 copies/mL.

Clients who are insured are more likely to be virally suppressed compared to those clients who are uninsured; 93% (n=1,081) of insured clients were virally suppressed compared to 87% (n=138) of uninsured clients.

The percentage of clients virally suppressed in the New Orleans Region is similar to the statewide percentage of 91%.

CARE CONTINUUM FOR CLIENTS BY INSURANCE STATUS



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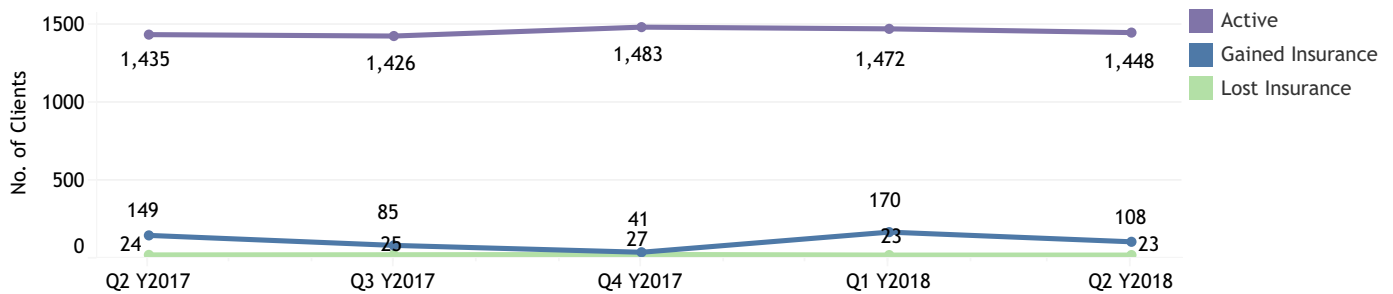

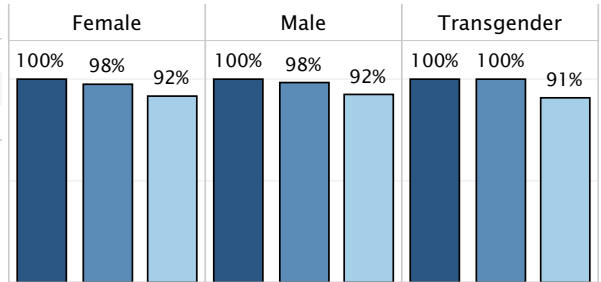

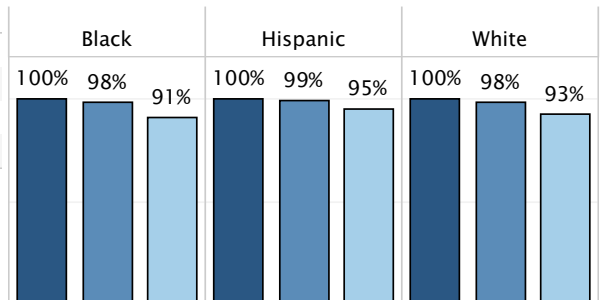

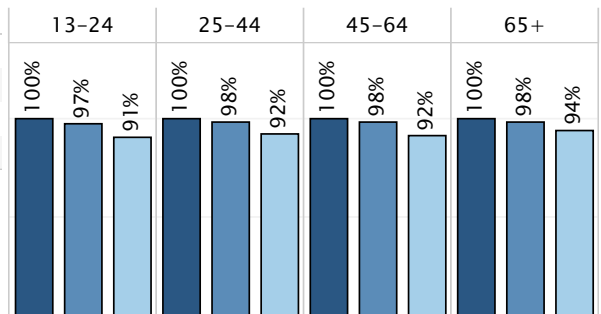

During the quarter, 976 clients were enrolled in the Louisiana Health Access Program (LA HAP) of which 3% (n=29) were first time enrollees.

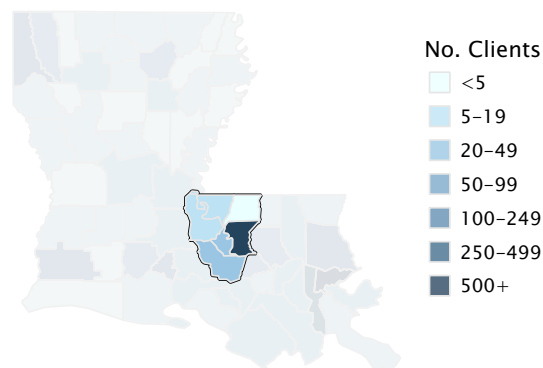
There were 18 clients who disenrolled from the program.

A total of 92 clients enrolled in the program to receive health insurance assistance who had previously been receiving uninsured assistance during the quarter.

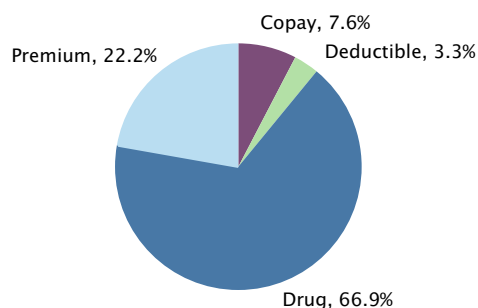
There were 19 clients enrolled in the program to receive uninsured assistance only who had previously been insured during the quarter.

LA HAP assisted with 10,766 claims including 7,198 (67%) drug claims, 821 (8%) copays, 355 (3%) deductibles and 2,392 (22%) premiums. Of these, 10,493 (97%) were for insured claims and 273 (3%) were for uninsured claims.

There were an average of 12.8 claims per person.

There were 784 clients who utilized health insurance assistance and 67 clients who utilized uninsured assistance.

26% of all LA HAP claims were for clients from the Baton Rouge Region.

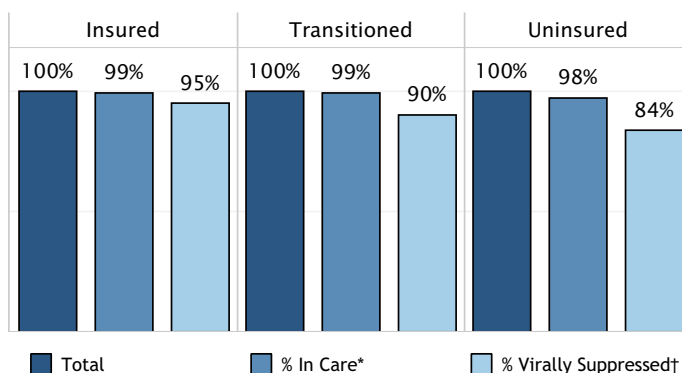
Nearly all clients (99%, n=967) were defined as in care. These clients had at least one CD4 or viral load test reported in the past year.

94% (n=917) of clients were virally suppressed. These clients had a viral load test reported in the past year with the most recent result <200 copies/mL.

Clients who are insured are more likely to be virally suppressed compared to those clients who are uninsured; 95% (n=756) of insured clients were virally suppressed compared to 84% (n=68) of uninsured clients.

The Baton Rouge Region has the highest percentage of clients virally suppressed in the state.

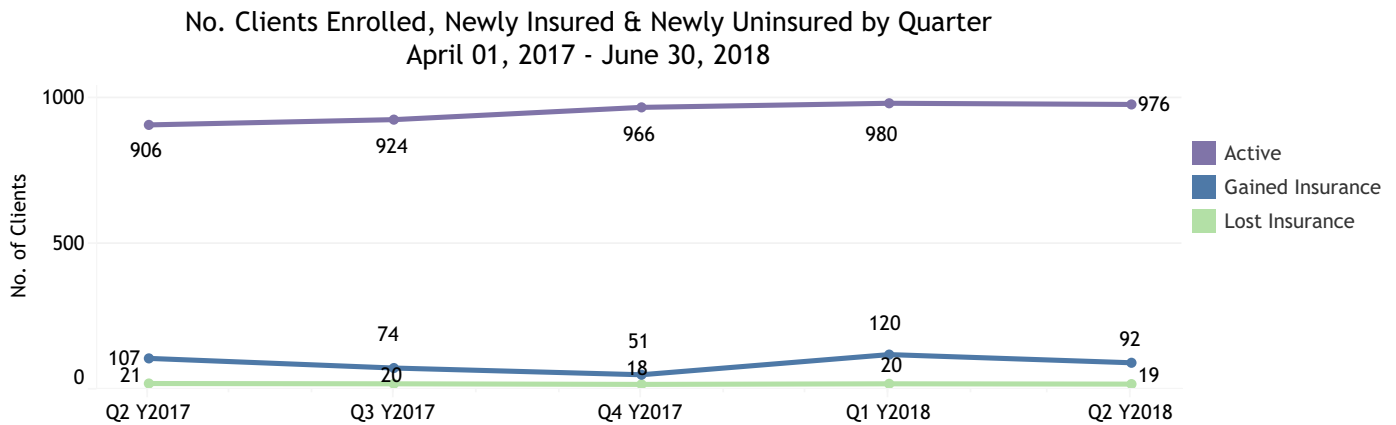

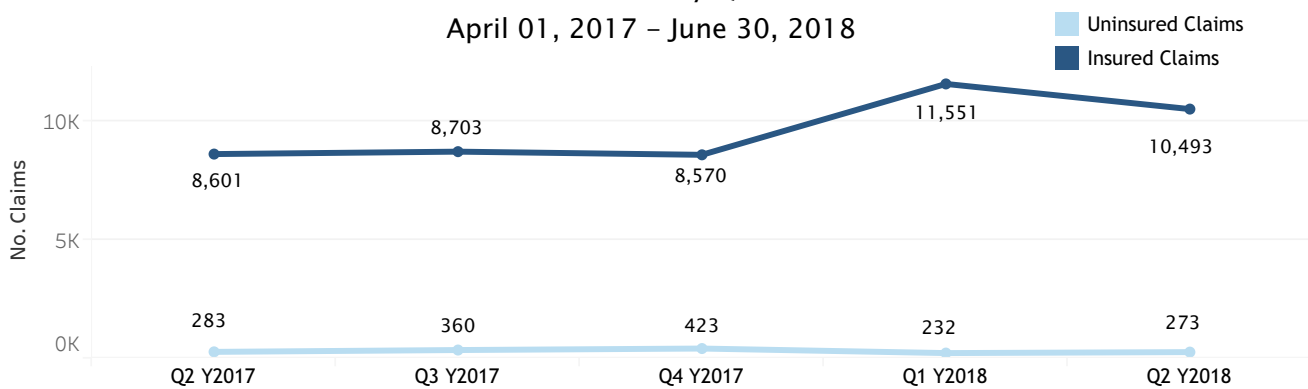

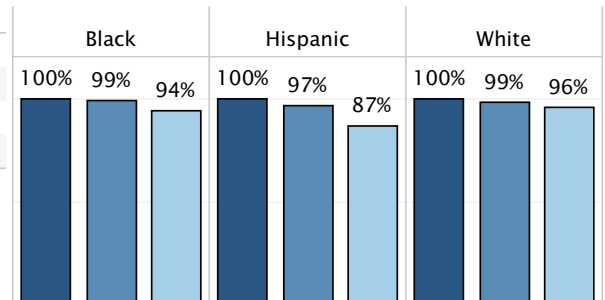

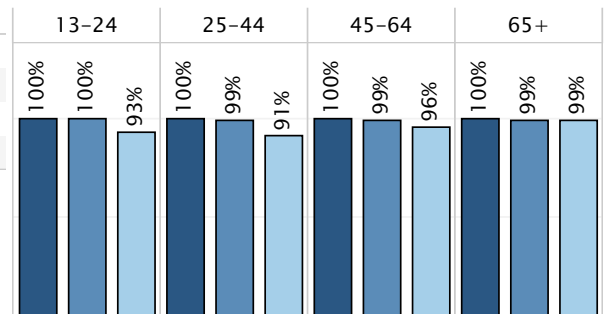

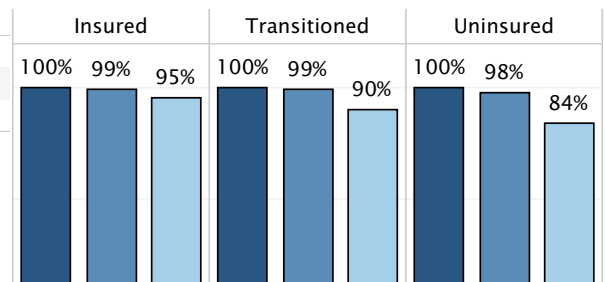

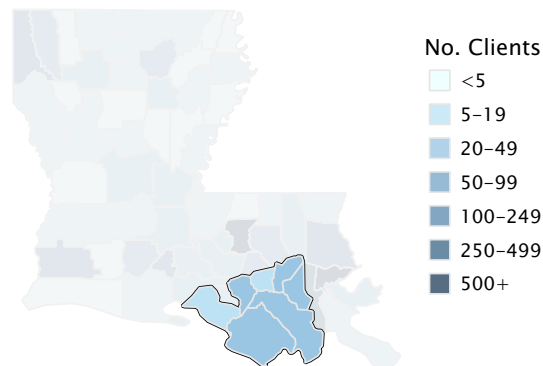

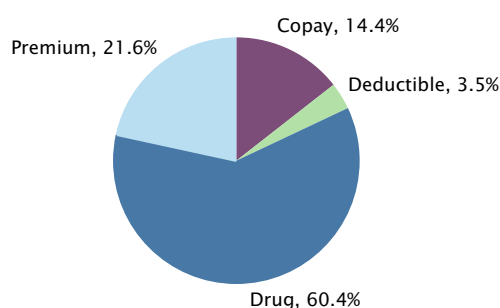

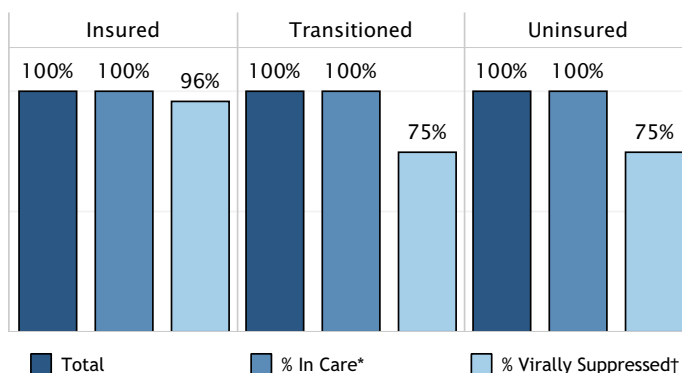

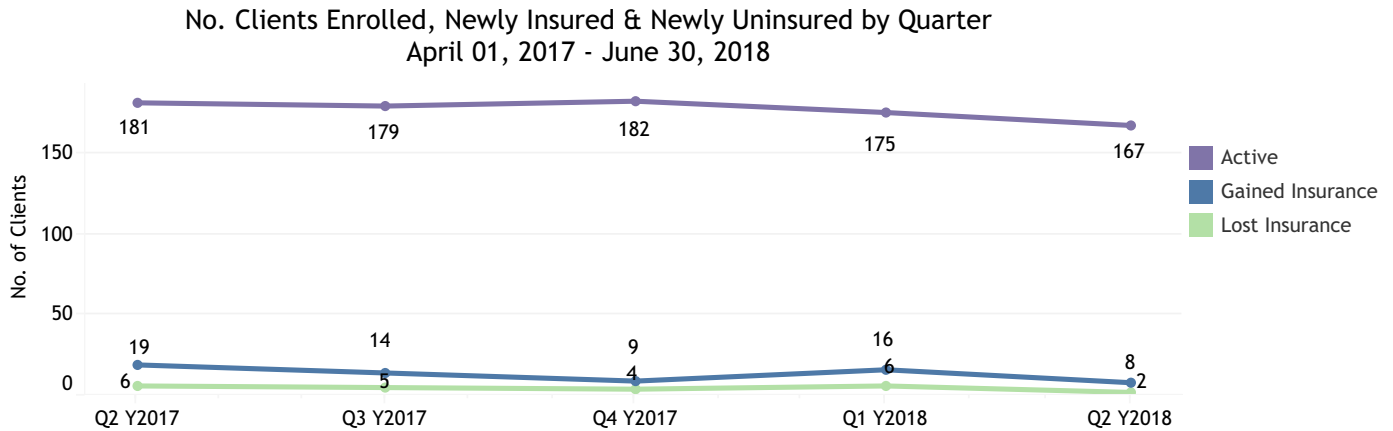

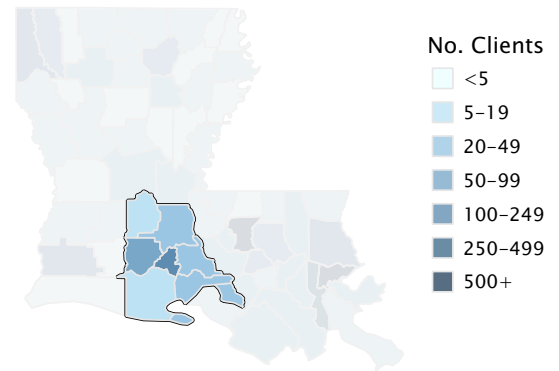

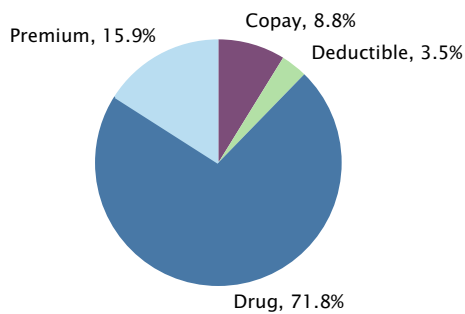

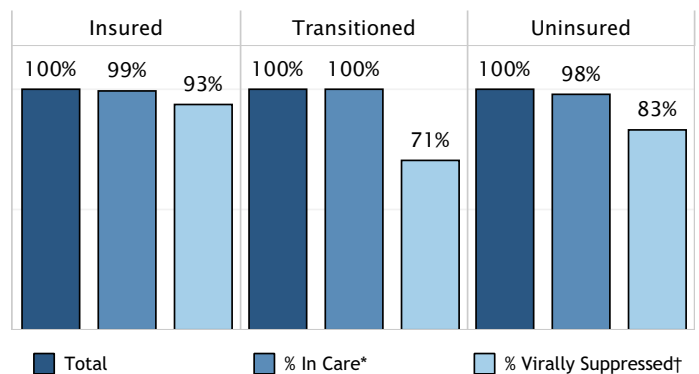

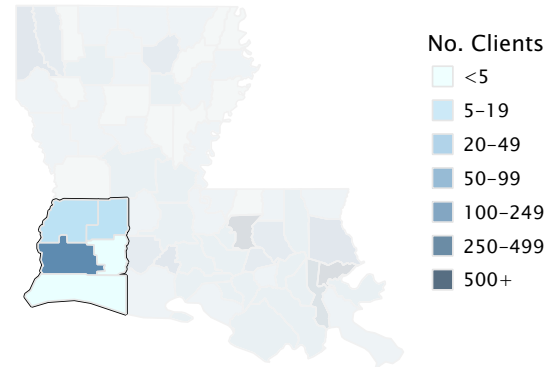

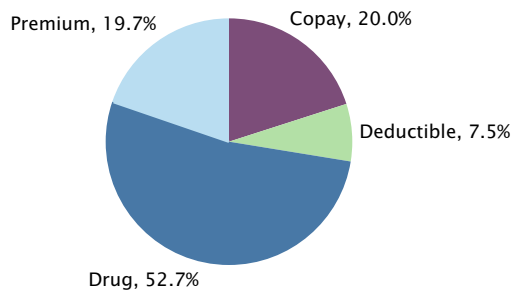

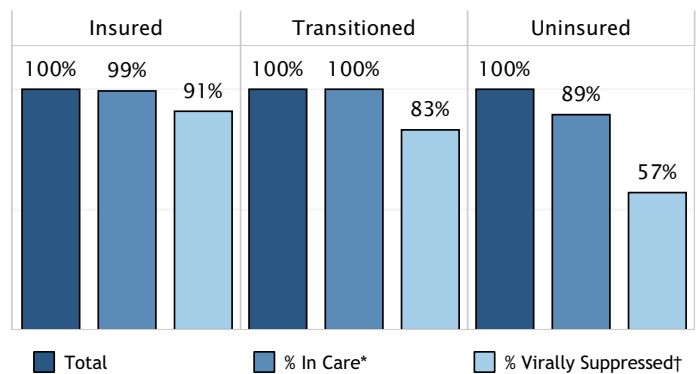

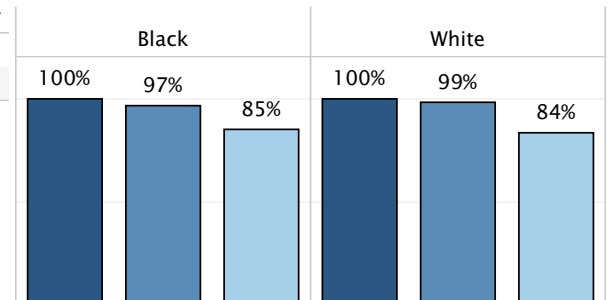

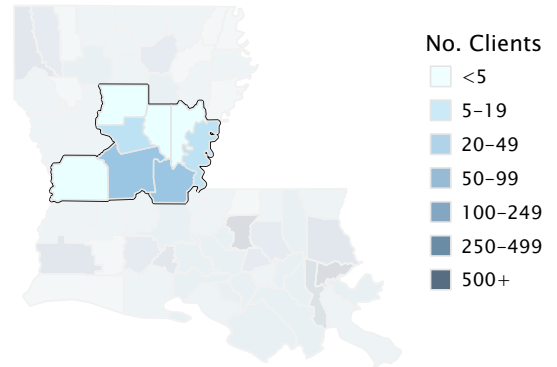

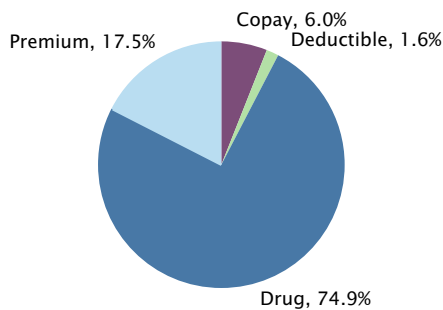

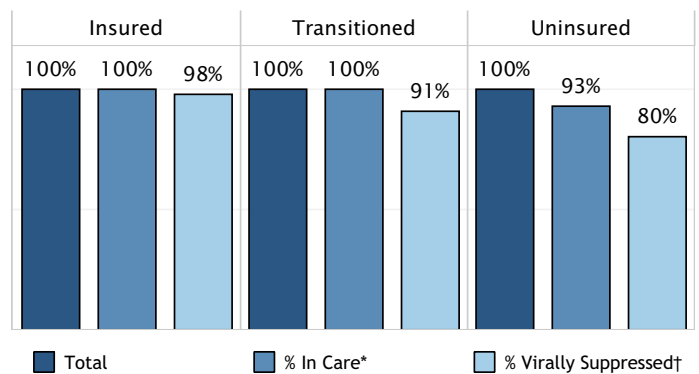

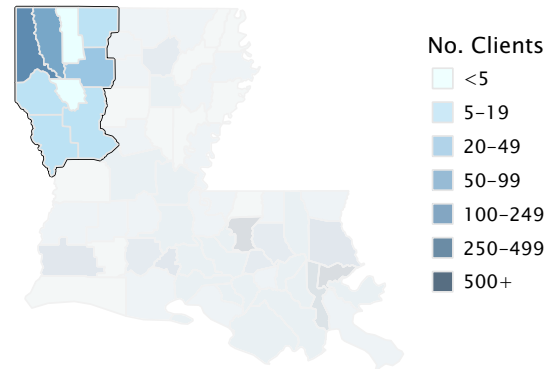

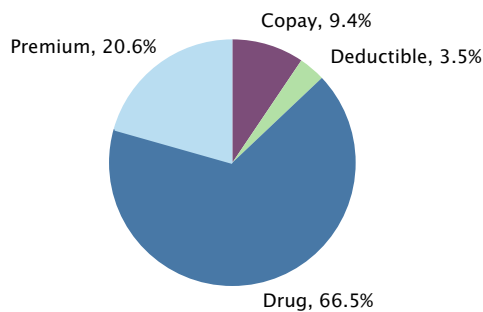

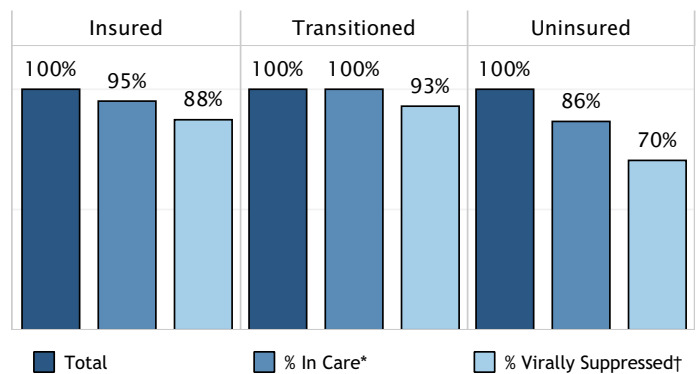

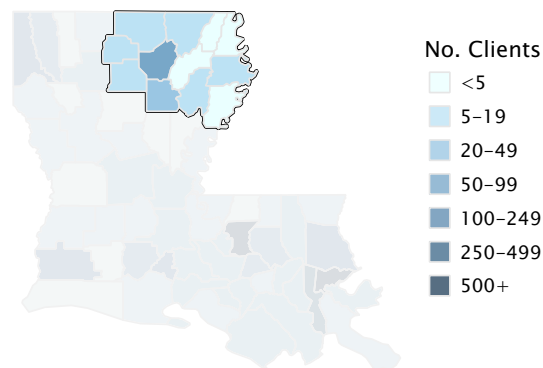

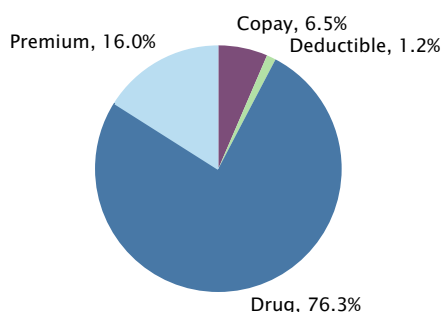

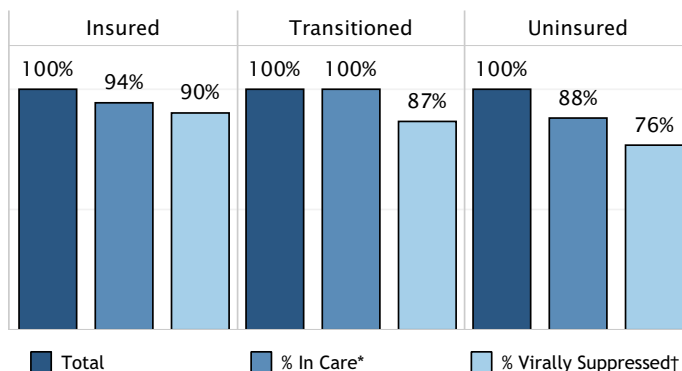

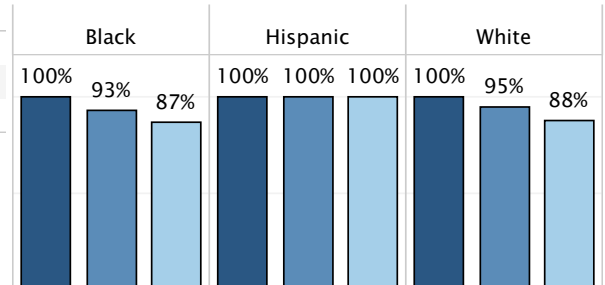

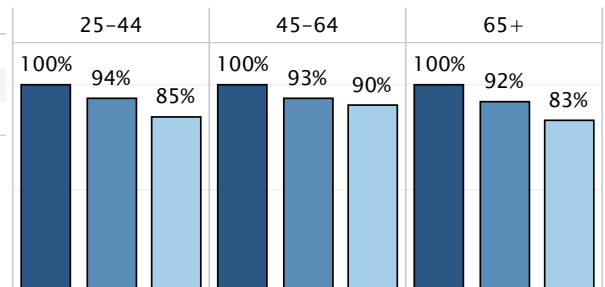

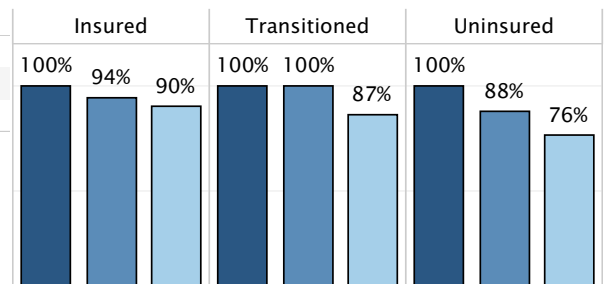

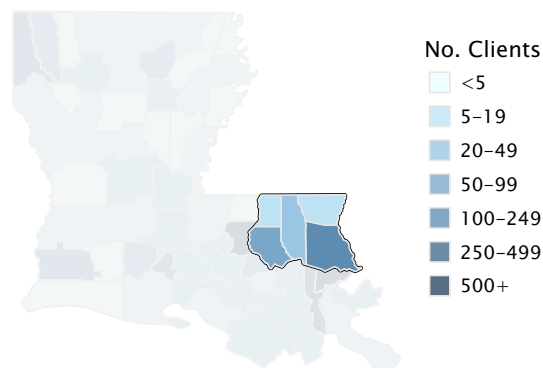

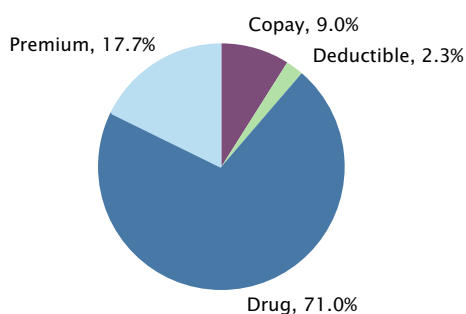

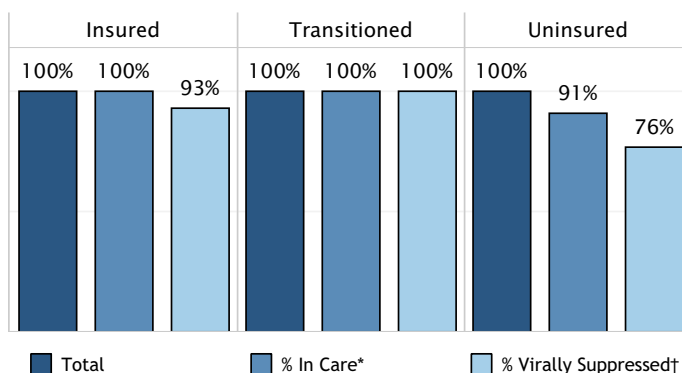

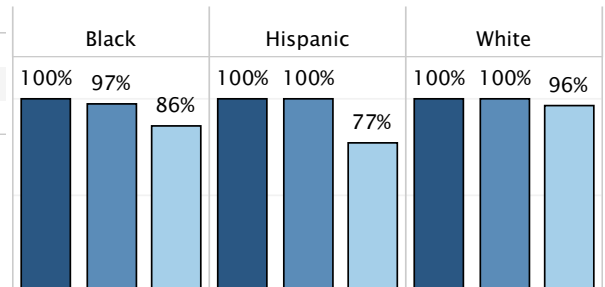

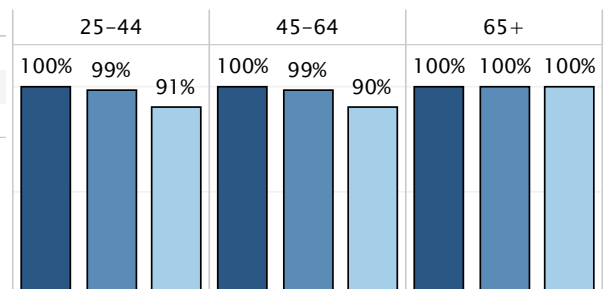
