For Initial licenses:

• Applicants must have completed an initial course within the last 24 months and have the course documented in the training profile with attendance and passing grade.

For License renewals:

- Applicants can begin applying on April 1st of their license renewal year and must have completed 16 hours of continuing education documented in the training profile.
 Continuing education and license renewal applications must be completed before the September 30th license expiration date.

For Initial Licenses:

- Applicants must have a valid, unrestricted NREMT certification for the license level chosen in the application
- All initial license applications must complete the <u>required state and federal background</u> <u>check</u>.
- Applicants who hold an EMS license or certification in another state will be asked to complete a <u>Louisiana Reciprocity form</u>.
- To be eligible for an EMT license in Louisiana without holding any other state license, the applicant will need to pass the psychomotor exam. Please contact the Exam
 Coordinator, 225-925-7214, to schedule an exam.

For License renewals:

 Applicants can begin applying for the license renewal beginning October 1st of their license renewal cycle after successfully renewing his or her NREMT certification.

- Applications for license renewal must be completed prior to the March 31st expiration date
