LOUISIANA CHILD DEATH REVIEW PANEL RESPONSIBILITIES

- Establish a standardized child death investigation protocol which shall require that all death investigations be completed within thirty working days of the report of the death.
- Establish criteria for information that must be included in a death investigation report and provide such information to the appropriate agencies and medical providers to be used as a guideline in preparing the death investigation report.
- Collect, review, and analyze all death investigation reports, and other information as the state panel deems appropriate, to use in the preparation of reports concerning the causes of and methods of decreasing unexpected deaths of infants and children.
- Recommend changes within the agencies represented on the state panel that may prevent child deaths.
