LOUISIANA RARE DISEASE ADVISORY COUNCIL RESPONSIBILITIES

- 1. Provide expert and clinical advice to the board in its review of treatments for rare diseases.
- 2. Provide input to the department and any other state agency on matters that affect a person who has been diagnosed with a rare disease such as:
 - Pandemic preparedness, response and its impact.
 - Research, education, diagnosis and treatment.
 - Severity of rare diseases and associated unmet medical needs.
 - Demographics and clinical description of patient populations.
 - Timely access to screening, care, insurance or Medicaid coverage.
 - Impact of coverage, cost-sharing, tiering, and more.
