Addressed During 2007-2008, by Category



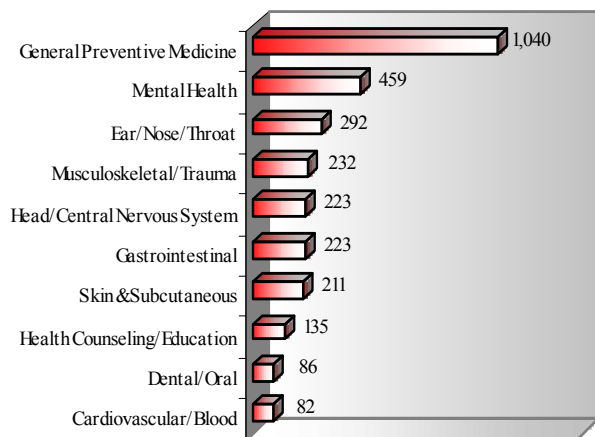

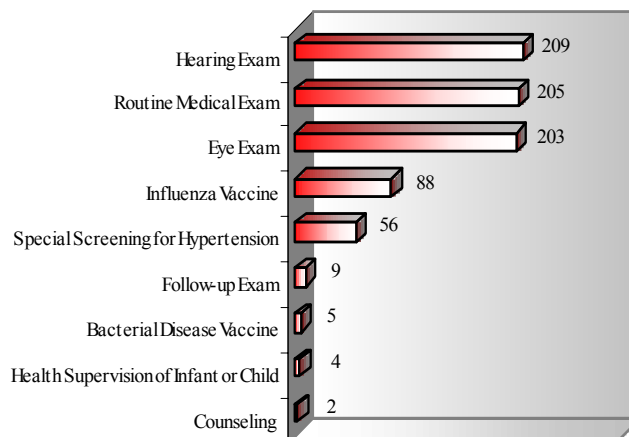
